# Locals protest quality of work

Lalmonirhat LGED official found irregularities in the widening work of a 6.24km road

Irregularities have been found in the widening work of a 6.24km long road stretching from Sadar upazila's Mogholhat area to Aditmari upazila's Durgapur area.

Local people are unhappy over quality of the road work.

The road is being developed under a project of Local Government Engineering Department (LGED).

Daud Ali got the work order of Tk 6.49 crore for widening the road, said LGED office sources, adding that it is scheduled to complete the work by June this year.

Daud got the contract using one Abdul Hakim's license, it added. Substandard materials are being used in the road widening work,

said villagers.

As poor quality brick chips were used, many parts of the road have already been damaged, said another villager Abdul Mannan.

Despite repeated pleas, LGED officials are yet to take any steps in this regard, said Mannan.

Contacted, contractor Daud Ali said he was not interested to talk to

In June last year, contractor of first class brick chips for the media about the quality of the road widening work.

He will explain it to the LGED authority if necessary, said Daud Ali.

Lalmonirhat LGED Executive Engineer Ashraf Ali Khan said he visited the site and found irregularities in the road work. The contractor has already been asked to complete the work with quality materials as per the

A 58-year-old mentally challenged woman, who was chained for over three decades, was rescued from her brother's house in Barlekha upazila on Wednesday.

Victim Habibun Nesa, wife of Mohibur Rahman of Zafarpur village, is now undergoing treatment at the upazila health complex, said Yasinul Haque, officer-incharge (OC) of Barlekha Police Station.

After being rescued from the house, Habibun Nesha was so weak and sick that she could not talk, said the OC. Police and family members said Habibun Nesha and

When Habibun Nesha became mentally unwell 32 years ago, her husband Mohibur married another woman and left the home with the children, leaving Habibun abandoned. Since then she was kept chained in the house of her elder brother Islam Uddin, a day labourer.

Mohibur have two sons and a daughter.

Habibun Nesha's sons Nazim Uddin and Alauddin, who have furniture business in the upazila headquarters, even do not stay in contact with her, said Islam.

Islam further said as Habibun Nesha is a mental patient, he kept her chained to a pillar in the house when he went outside for work.

Contacted, Nazim Uddin said he was not interested to talk about his mother.

On information, the OC rescued the chained woman from the house on Wednesday evening.

The police official then arranged her treatment at the health complex, said Islam.

After her recovery, they will ask the husband and children to take her to home, said the OC.

Police recovered Daiyan's body from

London on Tuesday

A teenage boy of Bangladeshi origin was killed allegedly by some unidentified criminals in London, United Kingdom (UK) on Tuesday.

The deceased, 17-year-old Shanur Ahmed Daiyan, was son of Sharif Ahmed Talukder of Gowalbari village in Moulvibazar's Juri upazila, relatives said.

UK police recovered the body Daiyan, a grade-11 student at Newham College in London, on Tuesday afternoon and sent it to hospital.

Victim's family members and relatives are yet to see Daiyan's body as of filing of this report yesterday afternoon (Bangladesh time).

Relatives at Daiyan's ancestral home in Moulvibazar are mourning his untimely demise.

On Monday, Daiyan went to college as usual. On the same day, two groups of students at the college had a fight in which one of Daiyan's friends sustained

Daiyan later returned home and was about to take his mother to a hospital when he received a phone call, with the caller asking him to visit his friend at the hospital near

Daiyan went to the hospital with some other friends and from then he remained missing until police recovered his body after conducting a search in the neighbouring areas.

Primarily, it is assumed that he was killed by miscreants. "Daiyan was a meritorious student and peaceful boy. We don't know if he had any enmity with anyone at the college," said his paternal uncle Saleh Uddin, also chairman of East Juri Union Parishad.

## Hospital vandalised over patient's death

Doctors' negligence, wrong treatment alleged for the incident

Angry family members and relatives went on a rampage at private hospital in Patuakhali town on Wednesday night following the death of a patient due to alleged wrong treatment.

The deceased, Irin Akhter Munni, 21, mother of a four-year-old daughter, was wife of Ali Ahmed of Chaurasta area in

Deceased's father Nurul Amin said Munni was admitted to Sharif Hossain-Sonabanu Specialized Hospital with severe pain in her stomach on Wednesday afternoon.

Staffers immediately took her to the Operation Theatre (OT), where on duty doctors pushed her an injection without conducting any medical test, he alleged.

After couple of hours, as her condition was worsening, they applied the same injection again but my daughter died inside the OT around 10:45pm, he added.

Being angered by the incident, is lodged in this regard.

Munni's family members and relatives went on a rampage and vandalised the hospital the same night.

Protesters also confined two on-duty doctors of the hospital to a room for over two hours.

On information, police went to the spot, brought the situation under control and rescued the two doctors from their confinement.

Victim's mother Mahinur Begum said, "My daughter died due to negligence of the doctors and I want proper justice in this regard."

When contacted, one of the doctors ATM Nasir Uddin said there was no negligence and irregularities in treating the patient.
