## Man killed over land dispute in Ctg

A 55-year-old man succumbed to his injuries yesterday morning after sustaining injuries in a clash between two groups over a piece of land at Patiya upazila on Friday.

Deceased Md Hashem hailed from Banigram area under Kolgaon union.

Assistant Sub-inspector Alauddin Talukdar of Chattogram Medical College Hospital police outpost said, "Hahsam sustained head injuries from the clash and died at the hospital around 10:30am while undergoing

Police sources said there had been longstanding enmity between Hashem and his neighbour Habibur Rahman over a piece of land. Around 3pm on Friday, the two and their supporters locked into a clash over the issue.

During the clash, the groups set several houses in the area on fire, leaving three critically injured.

Later, fire fighters doused the blaze and sent the injured

to the CMCH for treatment. OC of Patiya Police Station Borhan Uddin said Hashem's body was sent to CMCH morgue for autopsy.

# 2 hurt in N'ganj fire

A couple suffered burns in a fire that originated apparently from a gas leak at Kanchpur in Sonargaon upazila of Narayanganj early yesterday.

Ashraf (45) and his wife Rozina (35) suffered 75 and 63 percent burns respectively.

Inspector Bacchu Miah, in-charge of Dhaka Medical College Hospital police outpost, said they initially assume that there was a leak in the gas pipeline.

The fire started when an oven was being lit in the morning. After bringing the fire under control, the injured were rescued and taken to DMCH, Bachchu said.



"We organised a Facebook poll where students from

all five (current) batches opined to boycott all academic activities. Class representatives of the batches have informed the chairperson of this decision in writing and notified other teachers via E mail," Sarjis Alam, a class representative of the zoology department, said.

Contacted, chairperson of the department Prof Humayun Reza Khan said, "We have no jurisdiction to suspend class, only university syndicate can take such a decision. I have told teachers to attend classes but if the students do not come then classes will be considered automatically cancelled.

"We cannot ask students to take part in classes in such a situation if they do not wish to come," he added.

Students of Economics department organised a similar poll where 650 current students voted in favor of boycotting classes.

Meanwhile, students from some departments of Buet appealed to the university authorities to suspend academic activities. "Class representatives of some departments have contacted me and some have submitted application demanding suspension of all academic activities. We are yet to take any decision in this regard. If the students want this, and if health experts advise accordingly, then we will take a decision on this," Buet's Directorate of Students' Welfare Prof Mizanur Rahman told The Daily Star.
