A cooperative in Bagerhat closes its restaurant to produce low-cost masks

Until March 20, Vumi Book Café and Guest House in Bagerhat were like any other small-scale hotel, serving customers hearty meals and

As the coronavirus infections cases rose in the country, Greater Unity for Reality (GUR), the cooperative society that runs the place, felt the urge to do something.

They turned the café into a facility for producing low-cost surgical masks

While local vendors were selling similar masks for Tk 20 to Tk 30, the cooperative began selling their product for a price below Tk 10. "We have closed our café and are only making home deliveries of food," said Mir Jaesi Asrafi Jems, project director of Vumi Book Café

Says UN report, warns increased concentration of pollutants could make matters worse

More and severe floods are likely in Bangladesh and India due to climate change, says a UN study published on

The UN report titled "World Water Development Report 2020" said apart from flooding, Bangladesh will also be the country worst hit by droughts due to increased concentration of pollutants and low-quality groundwater

Housewife gangraped in Pabna

Five BCL men sued; one of them arrested

A housewife was gang-raped allegedly by Chhatra League activists in Char Sujanagai Bhabanipur area in Sujangar upazila on Sunday night.

The victim filed a case against five BCL men, including joint secretary of Sujanagar municipality unit BCL, the same night.

Police arrested an accused, Sumon Hossain Patol, 22, of Char Sujanagar village, yesterday and produced him before a Pabna court that sent him to jail.

Quoting the case statement, Hadiul Islam, officer-in-charge (investigation) of Sujanagar Police Station, said the woman, 30, of Santhia upazila, was going to her sister's house in Kuladi village of Pabna Sadar upazila.

When she reached Sujanagar Bazar on Sunday afternoon, her brother-in-law came to receive her. But the BCL men, led by Sumon Khan, joint secretary of Sujanagar municipality unit BCL, halted them and beat up her brother-in-law.

They then took the woman to a wheat field and raped her, the OC said, quoting the case statement.

The victim was sent to Pabna General Hospital for medical tests yesterday, he

Record case

torture of Kurigram journalist

The High Court yesterday directed police to immediately record Kurigram journalist Ariful Islam's assault and attempted murder case against Deputy Commissioner Sultana Pervin, three of her colleagues, and the ansar personnel concerned.

In the early hours of March 14, a mobile court of Kurigram district administration, led by three assistant commissioners and allegedly following DC Sultana's directives, convicted and sentenced Ariful to one-year imprisonment after arresting him at his home for possession.

Yesterday, the HC also stayed for six months the proceedings of the case filed by the mobile court against Ariful, his conviction, and sentencing. Besides, the court
