'I'M BACK', DECLARES MIKE TYSON

Former-world heavyweight champion Mike Tyson continued to tease boxing fans about a possible return to the ring by posting another training video on Instagram on Monday that ended with the message, "I'm back". The 53-year-old caught the attention of the boxing world last week when he posted a short video of a workout that showed he possesses plenty of the punching power and speed that allowed him to become the first heavyweight to hold the WBA, WBC and IBF titles. Tyson said then that he was considering a return to the ring for some exhibition bouts to raise money for charity. Since Tyson hinted at a return, challengers have been lining up for a shot at the boxel known as "Iron Mike".

Team training in Italy from May 18

Serie A clubs can return to team training from May 18 if they make adjustments to SERIE A medical protocols, the Italian government announced on Monday.

The Italian Football Federation (FIGC) met with the government's technical scientific committee (CTS) last week to discuss details for a return to group training as the country emerges from a two-month coronavirus lockdown.

Italy's sports minister Vincenzo Spadafora and health minister Roberto Speranza said in a joint statement on Monday that the CTS had largely accepted the FIGC protocol for a resumption of group sessions.

"The opinion requested by the government from the Technical Scientific Committee confirms the line of prudence," the ministers' statement said.

The indications of the CTS, which are to be considered stringent and binding, will be sent to the Federation for the necessary adjustments of the protocol in order to allow for the safe resumption of team training starting from May 18."

Football has been suspended in Italy since March 9 amid the pandemic which has killed nearly 31,000 people in the

The Italian government has allowed squads to return to individual training sessions in team facilities from May 4.

But there remain issues to be decided

such as the quarantine of players in case of positive tests for coronavirus.

Italian football bosses want to follow the example of Germany, which returns to action on May 16, and where only positive cases would be put into isolation.

But the CTS insists football must comply with the general rule of two weeks in insolation for those who have been in contact with positive cases.

There are still 13 rounds of football to be played for some teams between mid-June, when the FIGC hopes to return to action, and August.

Since the return to training last week, Fiorentina and Sampdoria announced 10 positive tests. In addition, a Torino player tested positive.

Spadafora later stressed the many tests that will need to be carried out on Serie A footballers would not be done "to the detriment of citizens".

"If these changes are made, there may be collective training from May 18," the sports minister told Italian television. Whether the championship can resume, we will have to wait at least another week to see how the curve of contagion evolves and then be able to decide.'

One by one players have returned to Italy, with Juventus forward Cristiano Ronaldo observing a two-week quarantine and Swedish star Zlatan Ibrahimovic returning to AC Milan on Monday evening. Italy on Monday reported fewer than 1,000 people in intensive care for COVID-19 for the first time since March 10.

The Premier League should not restart until the number of new coronavirus cases has dropped significantly, Newcastle United defender Danny Rose said on Monday. Clubs have been in

any of that. "I think I'm getting tested on Friday, so we'll just have to wait and see," Rose, who is on loan from Tottenham Hotspur until the end of the season, added.

Kohli and Smith are like Federer and Nadal: AB



Former South Africa captain AB de Villiers said Virat Kohli's natural talent makes him a cricketing equivalent of Roger Federer while Steve Smith's mental fortitude matches that of Rafael Nadal.

In an chat with former Zimbabwe seamer Pommie Mbangwa, de Villiers spoke about the two batsmen and compared them with tennis greats Federer and Nadal.

"It's a difficult one, but Virat is definitely the more natural ball-striker, there's no doubt about that," de Villiers said. "In tennis terms, I'd say he's more like a [Roger] Federer whereas Smith is like a [Rafael] Nadal.

"Smith is mentally very strong and figures out a way of scoring runs - he doesn't look natural, but he ends up writing records and

doing amazing things at the crease. "I think mentally, Smith is one of the

best I have ever seen. Virat has also scored runs all over the world and won games under pressure," he added.

The world knows Kohli as a prolific cricketer but for de Villiers, he is a friend, who has interests beyond cricket.

"He's much deeper than just a cricket player...I think most people realise after a while that there's more to life than just cricket," de Villiers said. "...Virat's always been a thinker, he experiments (with) a lot of things, he loves trying new things out gym wise, what he puts in his mouth. He thinks a lot about life after life - what's to come, different religions, we talk about everything."

"Obviously, when it comes to the IPL, it's been more than friendship," De Villiers said, when asked who his best friends in cricket are. "Virat obviously - not only during the IPL, we chat throughout the year, which means it's different than just the IPL or cricketing friendship."
