Flooding worsens in the North, Northeast

occur at many places today.

Our correspondents from different districts reported on the flood situation.

In Bogura, the Jamuna was flowing 35cm above the danger level at the Mathurapara point in Sariakandi upazila yesterday noon.

Over 2,725 hectares lands of jute, 1,265 hectares of Aush, 33 hectares of vegetables, 41 hectares of Aman seedbeds, 10 hectares of maize and two hectares of Chili have been inundated.

If the flood water remains for around one week, all the crops will be damaged, said officials of the local administration and agriculture office.

Nurzahan Begum, 45, a resident of Noapara char said, "Water entered our house six days ago. We are passing days without cooking food since then."

In Gaibandha, the Brahmaputra in Fulchori point was flowing 63cm above the danger level around 12:00pm yesterday.

Over 65 hectares lands of jute, 36 hectares of Aush paddy, 11 hectares of Aman seedbeds, 20 hectares of Teel, 51 hectares of vegetables and 20 hectares of peanut in this area went underwater, said local agriculture officials.

In Kurigram, Dharla river was flowing 62cm above the danger level

at Kurigram bridge point and the Brahmaputra water was flowing 64cm above danger mark at Chilmari point yesterday morning.

Over 1.5 lakhs people of different upazilas have been marooned. Crops of over 1,792 hectares lands have been submerged.

The district's deputy commissioner Rezaul Karim said some 302 tonnes rice and Tk 36.50 lakhs in cash have been allocated for relief.

In Lalmonirhat, the Teesta river was flowing above 15cm of danger level at Teesta Barrage Point in Hatibandha upazila yesterday.

Water level is rising in all the rivers in the district due to the onrush of water from upstream hills, said local WDB officials, adding all the gates of Teesta Barrage have been kept open to reduce the water level.

Serajul Islam, a flood-hit victim in Dakshin Balapara village in Aditmari upazila, said they had taken shelter on the WDB dyke with their family members and cattle as their house was inundated.

He said they were subsisting only on dry food as they were yet to receive any government relief.

About 50 hectares of Aman paddy seedbed and several thousand hectares of maize, nuts and vegetable fields were submerged, according to local agriculture office.

Contacted, the district's DC said 80

tonnes rice and Tk 8.26 lakhs in cash were allocated for the flood victims.

In Netrokona, the flood situation has worsened in different areas of Kalmakanda upazila yesterday. Some 400 families were marooned in the low-lying areas.

Around 1,000 ponds were also flooded. Crops on 36 acres and aman seedbeds on 14-acre of land have also been flooded.

In Sirajganj, Jamuna is swelling above the danger level from yesterday morning. Over 2.5 lakhs people in five upazilas have waterlogged. A total of 172 flood centre has already opened in five upazilas.

In Thakurgoan, the water levels of Nagor and Kulik rivers were flowing 9cm above the danger level.

About a hundred flood-affected families in Ranishankoil upazila have taken shelter at Ranishankoil Degree College and The Sunrise Kindergarten.

Social distancing and personal hygiene to avoid Covid-19 are hardly being maintained as many of the victims are staying in crowded rooms in the shelter centres.

Contacted, the local UNO said 10kg rice and Tk 500 in cash were distributed among each of the victims.

to recover his Facebook account and arrest his accomplices.

Opposing the prosecution plea, defence lawyer Jyotirmoy Barua submitted a petition seeking bail along with cancellation of the remand, adding that his client was implicated in the case as part of a conspiracy to harass him.

Moreover, his client has been in jail since his arrest on May 3 from Benapole. So, he appealed to the court to cancel the remand prayer and grant him bail, Barua added.

After the hearing, the magistrate rejected the bail petition and placed Kajol on a two-day remand for interrogation.

Usmin Ara Beli, a member of Bangladesh Jubo Mahila League's Central Committee, on March 10 filed the case against Kajol.

On June 23, Kajol was shown arrested in a case filed against him with Sher-e-Bangla Nagar Police Station.

The case was filed by ruling party lawmaker from Magura-1 Saifuzzaman Shikhor.

The next day, another virtual court in Dhaka rejected Kajol's bail petition through videoconferencing.

Another case was also filed with Kamrangirchar Police Station against Kajol under the same act.

But the investigation officer of the case is yet to submit any petition to show him arrested in the case.

Fifty-three days into his disappearance, Kajol was found by Border Guard Bangladesh in Benapole on May 3.

He was then arrested initially on charges of trespassing, but was granted bail by a Jashore court.

However, that same evening he was shown held under section 54 of the Code of Criminal Procedure after police informed the court that three more cases against Kajol were now pending with different police stations in the capital.

The court then sent him to Jashore jail.

item posed no risk to the astronauts, spacewalk or the station, Nasa said.

Spacewalking astronauts wear a wrist mirror on each sleeve to get better views while working. The mirror is just 5 inches by 3 inches, and together with its band has a mass of barely one-tenth of a pound.

Cassidy and Bob Behnken, who followed him out without mishap, were conducting the first of at least four spacewalks to replace the last bunch of old station batteries.

Once the six new lithium-ion batteries are installed, the orbiting lab should be good for the rest of its operational life, according to Nasa. The big, boxy batteries — more powerful and efficient than the old nickel-hydrogen batteries coming out — keep the station humming when it's on the night side of Earth.

The battery replacements began in 2017, with previous crews putting in 18 lithium-ion batteries, half as many as the old ones replaced.

Cassidy and Behnken have six more to plug in before the job is complete. It's cumbersome work: Each battery is about a yard (meter) tall and wide, with a mass of 400 pounds (180 kilograms).

Their spacewalks are expected to continue through July before Behnken returns to Earth in August aboard a SpaceX Dragon capsule.

Behnken and Doug Hurley made history at the end of May with SpaceX's first astronaut launch.

This was the seventh spacewalk for both men. Each has spent more than 30 hours out in the vacuum of space.

crucial that everyone who needed it should have access to a vaccine.

"I am trying to convince high-income countries to reserve vaccines not only for themselves but also for low- and middle income countries. This is a stress test for solidarity," she said.

British Premier Boris Johnson concurred.

"If and when an effective vaccine is found, then we as world leaders have moral duty to ensure that it is truly

available to all," he said.

French President Emmanuel Macron was adamant about pooling efforts together.

"Let's refuse an every man for himself approach, let's continue to move forward together," he said.

Italy, one of the hardest hit by the pandemic, echoed his sentiment.

The EU is championing global cooperation in efforts to control and end the pandemic, in contrast to the United States and China's focus on national initiatives.

Thousands in Rakhine flee

The administrator could not be reached for comment by Reuters.

Min Than said the "clearance operation" described in the letter referred to military operations targeting "terrorists."

He said the administrator had misinterpreted the order from his ministry and that the operations would only take place in a few villages, not the dozens mentioned, but confirmed other details.

The operations could last up to a week, Min Than said by phone, adding that "those who remain will be those who are loyal to the AA."

On Saturday, government spokesman Zaw Htay said in a statement on Facebook the government had instructed the military not to use the term "clearance operations". He also said the letter ordering people to flee had been revoked.

He did not answer phone calls from Reuters seeking further comment. Reuters did not see the revocation instructions.

This year the Myanmar army has been fighting the AA, a group from the largely Buddhist Rakhine ethnic group that is seeking greater autonomy for the western region, also known as Arakan.

Dozens have died and tens of thousands been displaced in the conflict. Save the Children says 18 children were killed and 71 injured or maimed between January and March, citing local monitoring groups. The army says it does not target civilians.

"Clearance operations" is the term the Myanmar authorities used in 2017 to describe operations against insurgents from Rakhine's Muslim-minority Rohingya people. During those operations, hundreds of thousands of people fled from their homes. Refugees said the army carried out mass killings and arson, accusations the army has denied.

Rohingyas fled to neighbouring Bangladesh during that military crackdown, which the government said was a response to attacks by Rohingya insurgents.

The United Nations yesterday said in a statement it was concerned by intense fighting in Kyauktan, including reports people were trapped and houses damaged. It called on all parties to "respect international humanitarian law, fulfil their responsibilities and take urgent measures to spare civilians and civilian infrastructure".
