### China warns US

Pro-democracy protesters in the city as well as foreign governments say the law breaches the "one country, two systems" principle enshrined in the 1984 Sino-British treaty that guaranteed the autonomy of Hong

China yesterday appointed a hardliner to head a new national security agency in Hong Kong as police brought the first charges under the sweeping new anti-subversion

Zheng Yanxiong -- a party official best known for tackling protests on the mainland -- will lead the office se up by the legislation that empowers mainland security agents to operate in Hong Kong openly for the first time, unbound by the city's laws.

The appointment came as a man accused of deliberately driving his motorbike into a group of police officers became the first person in Hong Kong to be charged under the new national security law.

China's authoritarian leaders say the suite of powers will restore stability after a year of protests and will not stifle freedoms.

But police have already begun arresting people for possessing flags and banners while the local government has made clear certain political views, especially calls for independence, are now

On Thursday evening Nathan Law, one of the city's most prominent young activists, announced he had fled overseas to an undisclosed location, fearing arrest days after the pro-democracy party he helped found

The new national security agency is just one new element of Beijing's landmark law targeting subversion, secession, terrorism and colluding with foreign forces.

The office has investigation and prosecution powers and will monitor intelligence related to national security and process cases, in some circumstances handing then the mainland for trial.

Zheng rose through the ranks of the local government in southern Guangdong province which borders Hong Kong, to serve as secretary general of the provincial Communist Party committee.

The 56-year-old is known as a hardliner who stamped out oftenviolent anti-corruption protests that erupted in Wukan, a village in the province, in 2011 after a local activist died in police custody.

"He is a tough enforcer, a law and order person," Willy Lam, an expert on China's Communist Party at the Chinese University of Hong Kong, told AFP.

We would like to highlight that these quotations reflect an inaccurate picture regarding H&M's business practices. The published news is not a mirror image of our statements and does not echo our sentiment concerning the outlook of our business. Apex Spinning and Knitting Mills Limited did not face any order cancellations from H&M during these challenging times; the number of \$450,000 is not factual. We would also like to point out that Apex Spinning and Knitting Mills does not engage in the production of bras for any of our customers.

Furthermore, despite the fact that our factory did maintain responsible closure after March 25th, the direct quotation "There was no work during the entirety of April, so these cancelled orders led to a problem in the cash flow" is misquoted.

The statement "Meanwhile whatever orders were put on hold, are on hold. They will talk about those orders when the pandemic blows over," is also irrelevant, at the time of publishing Apex Spinning and Knitting Mills is running at full capacity with 100% H&M orders.

Lastly, we would like to state that we have a 27 year long-term mutually beneficial business relationship with H&M and they in turn have stood by their commitments to Apex, by taking deliveries as usual, during this unprecedented time.

The name of the company was misprinted, and we express regret for this inadvertent error.

We have on record a quote from a senior official of the company stating, "In total they have cancelled about 200,000 units, I'd say the value would be around ... \$450,000, but they have covered the

The official also stated, "We had some issues with foam cups, we make bras ... so they paid the liabilities of the foam cups. It's like 'It's okay brother, don't worry about it, we will pay for that'.'

In the same way, we have a direct quote about the state of the cash flow stating, "The situation is a little tight, because there was no work in April, we were out [of] extra money ... we had paid 60 percent of the money, so there is some problem with the cash flow." This quote was simplified for clarity to the statement made above.

We are happy to learn from the rejoinder that H&M is honouring its orders and fulfilling its commitments.

# Vietnam opens world's 'first'

While expensive for Vietnam, at \$250 a night it is not prohibitive for wealthy locals craving a few nights living like Donald Trump, the US President renowned for his love of all things that glitter.

The hotel wants "ordinary people to the super rich... to check-in" both physically and on social media, said Nguyen Huu Duong, chairman of Hoa Binh group that owns the hotel.

A gold-plated infinity pool overlooks the city, while meals at the 25-storey hotel in downtown Hanoi may be mixed with a mysterious "gold substance", according to the owners.

So far, the smattering of customers appear to be delighted with Hanoi's flashiest new digs.

"When I arrived here... I felt like a king, you know,

the Pharaoh... the king of Egypt," joked Phillip Park, a South Korean guest.

"I really enjoyed the luxury atmosphere," added Vietnamese guest Luong Van Thuan, saying he felt his status had automatically been "raised".

The relatively modest construction price tag was achieved by sourcing the gold plating locally significantly reducing costs.

"Our group has a factory that can do gold-plated stuff, so the cost for our equipment and furniture here is quite cheap," Duong said.

And the pandemic which has strafed global tourism has not put him off opening, with Vietnam winning praise for its swift lockdown which has contained the coronavirus spread.

"For sure next year, we will make money," he added.

Recently, the arrests included a ninth-grader boy, university teachers and students, writers, journalists, and cartoonist, it said, strongly condemning the arrests and calling on the authorities concerned to immediately release the arrestees and withdraw the cases

"The controversial act has further spotlighted the towering crisis in the government's capacity, efficiency, and management in tackling the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic following the arrests of ninth-grader boy, university teachers-students, writers, journalists, and cartoonist," said the rights group.

Faruq Faisel, regional director for Article 19, Bangladesh and South Asia, said, "There has been failure in the government's preparedness to control the transmission of coronavirus at the outset of the pandemic. Issues such as incoherence, opacity, and mismanagement in policy making stage to relief distribution at the local level have gradually been crystallised. We hoped that the government would focus on closing these loopholes. Unfortunately, now the policy of suppressing dissent and criticism seems to be on the top priority of the authority.

He said it is a shame for the democracy and human rights that a ninth-grade teenager has been prosecuted and arrested for criticising the government's decision on Facebook.

"The practice of free expression needs to be unimpeded in the cause of establishing a stable society and sustainable development. Despite repeated calls for enforcement of law in comply with the commitments, Bangladesh reiterated at the international platforms, such as the United Nations, the government is not taking effective steps to amend the controversial DSA," the regional director added.

He urged that prisoners be released on bail to prevent coronavirus infections in jail. In the last 30 days, about 45,000 people accused in various cases were granted bail in the virtual courts, he said, adding that the defendants in the DSA cases are not accused of any heinous case like murder, rape, terrorism, militancy or treason.

"Yet their bail processes are constantly facing obstacles," he said.

Faruq observed that, "Law enforcement agencies have been particularly active in arresting defendants in cases under the DSA compared to cases filed under other timetested existing laws. Recently, two university teachers in Rangpur and Rajshahi, one of whom was a female, were arrested at midnight immediately after the respective cases were

"On the contrary, the accused in serious cases like attempted murder and corruption fled the country on well-arranged chartered flights; law enforcers could hardly find a clue of their whereabouts until they were in headlines. This discriminatory trend in enforcement of law has become a major threat to democracy and the rule of law."

"We heard that the disease is spreading. There will be red zones and yellow zones in Dhaka and in these zones there will be lockdown again. So far, we are not seeing any improvement," said Nazrul Islam, a sanitary worker.

"If the government does not help us by giving jobs or relief, we shall starve to death in the future," he added.

Almost all the workers claimed that they did not receive any government support since the pandemic hit the country.

Construction worker Mazeda Begum, 50, said a couple of men from Roopnagar residential area, where she lives, took her family's particulars including NID and phone numbers at least six or seven times in the last three months, mentioning relief. However, they never got back.

"Before Eid-ul-Fitr, we received some special food like vermicelli from different people, occasionally. That too has stopped after Eid," she said.

Though the government declared many stimulus packages for different industries and sectors, there has been no special allocation for the urban poor or the informal sector

"At present, we don't have any fund to help the daily wage earners. I think the current crisis is temporary. Gradually, they will all be able to get back to their work, once we get back to normalcy. Since the lockdown has been relaxed, many of them are now getting contracts," KM Abdus Salam, secretary of the ministry of labour and employment, told The Daily Star on

"Employment of informal sector workers is ensured by various ministries but sometimes there are lack of coordination and poor management. We are trying to establish an employment directorate under our ministry so that we can work on their employment in a coordinated way," he

There are 48 million informal jobs in the country, according to the Bureau of Manpower Employment and Training, and informal sector workers constitute 87 percent of the country's total labour force, as per the International Labour Organization.

Bangladesh Labour Force Survey published in 2017 showed daily wage earners contribute 45 percent of the country's GDP.

Yet, these workers are not recognised under the Labour Act, 2006. Thus, they are not covered by minimum wage, receive no compensation in case of any workplace accident and have no job security or

## Thousands at risk of virus

Asar Ali Shekh, who have taken shelter at Mohila Badh (dam) on the Jamuna river in Sariakandi upazila, said, "We heard about Covid-19. But our homes washed away around seven days ago.

"That is why, we have taken shelter here. I think coronavirus have not reached here. So, it is not important for us to maintain social distance. Around 70-year-old man Azhar Ali, a

## Taiwan expels two Chinese journos over political shows

Taiwan expelled two mainland Chinese journalists yesterday after a talk show on their channel pushed for Beijing "unifying" with the self-ruled island, in the latest sign of deteriorating ties between the two rivals.

The move comes after a spate of tit-

for-tat expulsions of reporters between

China and the United States, as the two superpowers spar over trade and the coronavirus pandemic. The reporters with China Southeast TV were ordered to leave by yesterday for violating regulations covering mainland

journalists, according to the Mainland Affairs Council (MAC), Taiwan's top China policy body. They "are suspected of violating the regulations and the authorities have decided not to extend (their permits)... they are scheduled to leave on July 3,"

MAC spokesman Chiu Chui-cheng told reporters. Ai Kezhu, one of the deported journalists involved in producing the shows, told local media at Taoyuan international airport before her departure yesterday that they

were puzzled by the order.
