Shah Iftekhar Ahmed, deputy commissioner of Wari division police, said, "We are on alert and have already increased patrolling and vigilance so that this kind of crime could not take place," said. Omar Faruk, associate professor of criminology

Technology University, said the economic crisis during Covid-19 could lead to an increase in property-related crimes and fraudulence. "Law enforcers should be aware of such crimes and the government should ensure people's economic and
