SC extends stay order on paying victim families

The Supreme Court yesterday extended its chamber judge's order that stayed a High Court directive asking the United Hospital to pay Tk 30 lakh as initial payment to the families of the four victims, who were killed in a fire at its isolation unit on May 27.

A six-member bench of the Appellate Division of the SC headed by Chief Justice Syed Mahmud Hossain came up with the order after virtually holding hearing on a petition filed by the hospital authorities challenging

Following four separate writ petitions, a virtual HC bench of Justice M Enayetur Rahim on July 15 directed the hospital authorities to pay Tk 30 lakh to each of the four victims' families.

Yesterday, the Appellate Division asked the petitioners' lawyers to take initiative for hearing the petitions before a regular HC bench and get them disposed of through rule hearing from the HC.

The apex court said its stay order will not effect the HC hearing and disposal of the writ petitions, Mustafizur Rahman Khan, a lawyer for United Hospital, told The Daily Star.

He also said his client need not pay the money to the four families now following the SC order.

Following a stay petition filed by United Hospital, the SC chamber judge on July 21 stayed the HC order.

The apex court judge also sent the stay petition to the full bench of the Appellate Division for its hearing yesterday.

Niaz Mohammad Mahboob, who moved one of the petitions, told The Daily Star that the family of Monir Hossain, one of the five victims who were killed in the fire, had already been paid Tk 20 lakh as an initial payment by the hospital as a compromise.

Dhaka Bank official | Money Laundering Cases denied bail in Tk 22cr graft case

The High Court yesterday refused to grant bail to Dhaka Bank's Dhanmondi branch Vice President Md Aminul Islam in a corruption case filed on the charge of misappropriating Tk 22 crore.

The court, however, issued a rule asking the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) and government to explain in three weeks why accused Aminul Islam should not be granted bail in the case.

The HC bench of Justice Md Nazrul Islam Talukder and Justice Ahmed Sohel issued the rule after holding hearing on the bail petition filed by accused Aminul

Aminul cannot get released from jail following the HC order, Deputy Attorney General AKM Amin Uddin Manik told The

He said the ACC filed the case with Dhanmondi Police Station on December 23, 2018 against Aminul Islam and six others.

The case statement they misappropriated the money from the bank by submitting fake export bills through misusing powers.

Lawyer Sheikh Awsafur Rahman appeared for Aminul while Kamrunnesa Ratna represented the ACC.

Destiny MD denied bail

The High Court vesterday rejected two bail petitions filed by Destiny Group Managing Director Md Rafiqul Amin in connection with two money laundering cases involving Tk 4,200 crore.

The HC bench of Justice Md Nazrul Islam Talukder and Justice Ahmed Sohel passed the rejection orders, after holding a hearing on the two

The HC rejected the petitions as Rafiqul did not pay any money to the government in line with the Supreme Court's Appellate Division order, Deputy Attorney General AKM Amin Uddin Manik told The Daily Star.

He said the HC bench asked Rafigul to settle the issue. The HC also directed the lower court concerned to finish the trial proceedings of the money laundering cases against the Destiny officials

Lawyers Abdul Matin Khasru and Mainul Islam appeared for Rafigul during the hearing.

Rafiqul, now in jail, filed the petitions on August 16 through his lawyer Ujjal Bhowmick with the HC seeking bail in the cases against him on grounds that he has been suffering in jail for a long period of time since October 11, 2012 and he is now physically ill.

Meanwhile, Anti-Corruption Commission's Lawyer Khurshid Alam

Khan and DAG Manik opposed the bail petitions saying that Rafiqul cannot be granted bail as there are specific allegations of money laundering On November 13, 2016, Rafiqul and Destiny Multipurpose Cooperative Society Ltd Chairman Mohammad Hossain were granted bail by the Appellate Division on a condition that they must pay the government Tk

Hearing on charge framing against Khaleda Sept 17

A Dhaka court yesterday set September 17 for the hearing on charge framing against BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia and seven others in Barapukuria coalmine graft case.

Judge ASM Ruhul Imran of the Special Judge's Court-2 of Dhaka passed the order. Dewan Ashik, bench assistant of the court concerned, confirmed The Daily Star about the order.

On February 26, 2008, ACC filed the case with Shahbagh Police Station, accusing 16 people including Khaleda and 10 of her former cabinet colleagues of taking Tk 159 crore in kickbacks on the Barapukuria coalmine deal awarded to the highest bidder.

On October 5, 2008, ACC pressed charges against Khaleda and 15 others in the case.

Earlier, six accused including former ministers M Saifur Rahman and Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan died during the trial, while Jamaat leaders Ali Ahsan Mohammad Mojahid and Motiur Rahman Nizami were executed on charges of committing crimes against humanity during the Liberation War. Therefore, names of the eight were dropped from the trial.

Lawyer Mamun apologises to SC

Advocate Syed Mamun Mahbub yesterday offered unconditional apology to the Supreme Court for posting a derogatory status about Chief Justice Syed Mahmud Hossain and the judiciary on Facebook on August 11.

Syed Mamun Mahbub, an SC lawyer, virtually appeared before a full bench of the Appellate Division of the SC headed by the chief justice yesterday morning and apologised unconditionally to it during hearing on a contempt of court rule.

Sved Mamun Mahbub told the apex court that he had unintendedly and mistakenly used a word while posting a status on his Facebook and he deleted it from the platform. After hearing on the issue, the Appellate Division fixed

August 23 on the contempt of court rule. Several lawyers including senior counsels M Amir-Ul Islam, Rokanuddin Mahmud, Zainul Abedin, AJ Mohammad Ali and AM Amin Uddin appeared for Syed Mamun Mahbub while Attorney General Mahbubey Alam

and Additional Attorney General Murad Reza represented the state during the virtual proceedings yesterday. On August 12, the apex court summoned Advocate Mamun to appear before it on August 20 for posting a derogatory status about Chief Justice Syed Mahmud Hossain and the judiciary on his Facebook account on August 11. The top court issued a rule asking the lawyer to

explain why contempt of court proceedings should not be brought against him for posting the status. The apex court also prohibited Syed Mamun Mahbub to

practise in any court until its further order. The Appellate Division bench headed by Chief Justice Syed Mahmud Hossain came up with the order and rule after Attorney General Mahbubey Alam placed the issue before the bench.

Early this month, India's Ministry Bengal Chief Secretary Rajiva Sinha,
