Ensure safe, dignified return of Rohingyas

Rights activists, scholars adopt Dhaka declaration, call for int'l community's commitment

Human rights activists, Rohingyas and scholars from across the globe have adopted a Dhaka Declaration, calling for an unequivocal commitment from the world community to resolve the Rohingya crisis in a sustainable manner with a regional approach.

In a 15-point declaration, they called upon the UN and all members of the international community to use diplomatic channels to provide sufficient humanitarian assistance and other supports to protect Rohingya rights.

Recalling the promise of the Global Summit 2005, to take "timely and decisive action in accordance with the UN Charter" in situations of mass killings and mass eviction and the Global Compact for Refugees, they urged Myanmar to take responsibility and investigate the alleged genocide SEE PAGE 10 COL 4

Japanese firm to build bridge

A Japanese company is likely to build a bridge over the Tentulia and Kalabadar rivers to connect island district Bhola with Barishal under a Public Private Partnership (PPP) initiative.

A proposal to build the 4.68-kilometre bridge with a 4.9km elevated road -- the entire construction totalling nearly 10km -- by Miyagawa Construction Ltd was placed before the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs on Wednesday for its approval in principle.

The committee, led by Finance Minister AHM Mustafa Kamal, neither approved nor rejected the proposal tabled SEE PAGE 10 COL 1

45 more die, 2,436 test positive in a day

The health directorate yesterday reported 45 deaths of Covid-19 patients, raising the official tally to 4,127.

The authorities also detected 2,436 new cases across the country in 24 hours preceding yesterday afternoon.

The total number of Covid-19 patients in the country rose to 3,04,583.

Another 3,275 patients recovered from the disease in a day boosting the number of total recoveries to 1,93,458. The recovery rate has increased to 63.52

In yesterday's press release from the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), officials said RT-PCR facilities tested 15,124 samples in 24 hours of which 16.11 percent were positive.

Cheers as court sentences 'inhuman' white supremacist killer

New Zealand mosque gunman Brenton Tarrant was sentenced to life in prison without parole yesterday for the massacre of 51 Muslim worshippers, with a judge calling his actions "wicked" and "inhuman".

As the sentence was read out, there was jubilation outside the courtroom, with crowds cheering and
