

RESHUFFLE IN POLICE ADMIN

Seven DIG-ranked officials transferred

In a major reshuffle in Bangladesh Police, seven DIG level officials including two metropolitan police commissioners were transferred yesterday.

The home ministry in an order signed by Dhananjoy Kumar Das, deputy secretary of the Public Security Division, made the transfer, including that of Deputy Inspector General (Chattogram Range) Khandker Golam Faruq, under whose jurisdiction some police members in Cox's Bazar are facing trial in retired army major Sinha Md Rashed Khan murder case.

Md Anwar Hossain, Gazipur Metropolitan Police commissioner, will replace DIG Faruq. Faruq has been transferred to Bangladesh Police Academy, Rajshahi.

Since the Sinha murder on July 31, DIG Faruq has been stationed in Cox's Bazar to oversee the law and order situation of the district, sources said.

Chattogram Metropolitan Police (CMP) Commissioner Md Mahabubor Rahman has also been transferred to Industrial Police in Dhaka as DIG. Saleh Mohammad Tanvir, additional police commissioner of Dhaka Metropolitan Police, has been made new CMP commissioner.

Among other officials, Md Abdullah Baqi, DIG at Bangladesh Police Academy in Rajshahi, has been transferred as DIG of criminal investigation department (CID); Jamil Ahmed, additional inspector general of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab), has been transferred to CID; and Imtiaz Ahmed, DIG at the CID transferred, has been transferred to Rab.

They have been sent to jail, said Ashraful Alam, officer-in-charge of Khulna Sadar Police Station.

"We have prayed for five-day remands for each. We will investigate the incident further," the official added.

According to the case statement, the four came to Yusuf's house and demanded Tk five lakh over a contract work. "They threatened to kill me if I didn't pay," Yusuf said.

However, relatives of the youths said the altercation did not take place over extortion, but due to a romantic complication involving Yusuf's daughter.

Asked, the OC said they are considering the matter in their investigation.

Md Sohel, uncle of accused Saiful Islam, said Yusuf provided false information in the case statement to conceal the real issue -- a love affair between one of the arrestees and Yusuf's daughter.

However, Yusuf Ali denied the allegations and termed them baseless.

SCHOOL DROPOUTS

Special funds needed to bring them back to classrooms: speakers

The government has to allocate a special fund to bring children who have dropped out, back to the classroom as many of them have been involved in income-generating work to help their families during the pandemic, speakers said at a webinar yesterday.

Over the years, the government has achieved great success in enrolling almost 100 percent children in school. But now it is a big challenge for the government to maintain this, they told the event titled "Education Sector Plan of SDG", by Campaign for Mass Education (CAMPe) and Darpan.

Speakers said, as educational institutions remained closed during the pandemic, the government arranged online and television class for school students. But 100 percent children could not be brought under this system, especially children from rural and marginal areas.

The government has to arrange special funds and properly use it to provide incentive to underprivileged children to enrol in school, they added.

The speakers also said the government also has to train teachers to prepare them for better quality online classes.

Abul Fazal Mir, deputy commissioner of Cumilla participated in the programme as chief guest while Rasheda K Chowdhury, former adviser to the caretaker government and executive director of CAMPe was present there as guest of honour. Eminent educationist Dr Monzur Ahmed chaired the session.

Tk 80 LAKH RECOVERY

Charges against suspended DIG prisons accepted

A Dhaka court yesterday took cognisance of the charges against Partha Gopal Banik, a suspended deputy inspector general (prisons) of Sylhet division, in a case filed over the recovery of Tk 80 lakh from his capital's residence.

Judge KM Emrul Kayesh of the Senior Special Judge's Court of Dhaka passed the order after scrutinising case dockets and other relevant documents.

The judge fixed October 29 for hearing on charge framing against the accused. The judge also transferred the case to the Special Judge Court-10 of Dhaka for trial.

On July 29 last year, ACC Director Mohammad Yousuf quizzed Partha over allegations that he committed irregularities and corruption as DIG (prisons) of Chattogram division.

ARMS CASE

Trial of Papia, her husband begins

The trial of an arms case filed against expelled leader of Jubo Mohila League Shamima Nur Papia and her husband Mofizur Rahman began yesterday at a Dhaka tribunal with deposition of a prosecution witness.

Judge KM Emrul Kayesh of the Special Tribunal-1 of Dhaka recorded the statement of Sub-inspector Md Saiful Islam of Rapid Action Battalion-1, who prepared a seizure-list of the arms case.

After the court recorded his statement, defence lawyer sought time to cross-examine the witness. The tribunal then fixed today for cross-examination.

In his statement, the witness told the court that on February 23, a team of Rab including him raided Papia's Indira Road house in Farmgate and recovered a foreign pistol, two magazines, 20 bullets, five bottles of foreign liquor, Tk 58,41,000 in cash, and credit and debit cards of different banks.

Later, he prepared a seizure list in front of the witnesses, Saiful added.

Before that, Papia, her husband -- a former Chhatra League leader -- and their two accomplices were arrested from Dhaka's Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport on February 22 when they were trying to leave the country.

Rab members recovered seven passports, Tk 2,12,270, fake notes worth Tk 25,600, \$11,481, 420 Sri Lankan rupees, 301 Indian rupees, and two debit cards from their possession.

125 luggage vans after 40 years; it is not only giving important on passenger services but also on goods transport, he said.

NO PLAN TO HIKE TRAIN FARE NOW

Several newspapers recently ran reports that BR is mulling hiking passenger and freight fares to improve service and minimise loss.

"There is a committee [to review train fare], which has placed their opinion before us. Some media ran report giving 'wrong explanation' of the meeting," Sujan said.



really important matter. She also emphasised on the need for up-to-date curriculum for technical education.

The government has set up a target to have 20 percent students under technical education by 2020 and 30 percent by 2030 and 50 percent by 2050, said technical education board chairman Morad Hossain Mollah.

Many guardians are reluctant about their children receiving technical education as it was traditionally considered for academically weak students and there is a stigma associated with that.

According to Bangladesh Bureau of Educational Information and Statistics, there are 11,00,177 students enrolled in 16 types of 7,052 technical and vocational institutes in 2019.

The numbers of such educational institutions and their students are increasing steadily. The number of institutions were 1,137 in 2000; 2,317 in

2003; 5,790 in 2015 and 5,897 in 2017.

The total number of students were 1,16,055 in 2000; 1,88,686 in 2003; 8,72,658 in 2015; 8,75,270 in 2016 and 8,91,964 in 2017.

Mentionable, an overwhelming 95 percent of the institutions are privately managed.

At the webinar, madrassa teachers' leaders demanded the government to bring independent Ebtedayee madrassas under monthly pay order (MPO) system as the teachers are facing hardship due to meagre amount of salary.

Dipu Moni said government is working on the issue.

Technical and Madrasah Education Division Secretary Aminul Islam Khan, Bangladesh University of Textiles Vice Chancellor Prof Abul Kashem; madrassa education board chairman Prof Kaiser Ahmed and Education Reporters Association leaders also spoke at the webinar.

He had been the founding president of Bangladesh Hindu-Buddha-Christian Oikya Parishad, a platform of different religious minority groups, until his death.

Dutta, who was the founding director general of Bangladesh Rifles in 1973, left behind two daughters, a son, and a host of relatives and well-wishers.
