### Musk plans IPO for SpaceX's Starlink business

Tesla Inc Chief Executive Officer Elon Musk plans to list SpaceX's space internet venture, Starlink, several years in the future when revenue growth is smooth and predictable. "Public market does \*not\* like erratic cash flow haha,

the billionaire entrepreneur tweeted here on Monday.

Musk said last year that Starlink was an important new revenue stream for his California-based Space Exploration Technologies, or SpaceX. SpaceX President Gwynne Shotwell in February floated the idea of spinning Starlink off for an IPO in the coming years.

### Deadline for loan rescheduling extended again for rawhide traders

# Adequate data needed to capture true impact of Covid-19

LFS adheres to definitions provided by ILO. This is useful for international comparison. But this may often result in misleading interpretation in national contexts. To capture the impact of pandemic, data collection efforts can be meaningful if these are based on concepts which are suitable in the socio-cultural context of the country. Therefore, modification of some of the definitions should be considered.

Timing of the surveys: The latest round of LFS has been completed in June 2017. The next one, even if starts early next year will mean an interval of 3.5 years. Thus, an analysis of the impact of Covid-19 will miss out information on both ends.

There is no updated information on 2018, 2019, which could form the base year for comparison. One has to depend on the assumption of continuation of parameters of 2017 and make projection for 2019 as the base year.

The survey will commence one year after the beginning of the pandemic. This will be useful

to capture the medium-term impact but cannot capture the impact and the processes associated with it in the initial peak pandemic period (hopefully there will be no second wave) and the government responses during those months. To understand the process of change of the labour market in the short run and its comparison with the medium term, the survey will have to depend on memory recall.

Appropriate questions should be included in the survey to generate data through such recall. It will be a complex matter and will require quite some details including recall of three points of time: immediately before Covid-19, during April-June 2020 and at the time of the survey in

One must balance the usefulness of detailed data generation through recall with the likely

decline in quality of such data. Poverty and household income data

During the last three decades, Bangladesh has been assessing poverty incidence on the basis of data of Household Income and Expenditure Survey (HIES). This is usually conducted at 4/5 years of intervals.

The latest round has been completed in 2016. The next round has not yet started and may be expected to commence in 2021. In the normal situation this serves the purpose of poverty assessment and analysis of the factors behind

However, with the spread of coronavirus, there has been evidence from rapid surveys that poverty has accentuated. But these surveys are not based on nationally representative samples. Therefore, these cannot be compared with the national survey results. Then how would one

arrive at national estimates of poverty during the various phases of the pandemic? HIES poverty estimates use detailed information of consumption of individual food items and other consumption items during a short reference period. It will not be possible to collect such details through recall method for periods three to six months earlier. The method of obtaining idea about consumption standard or poverty during the pandemic is not thus, quite straightforward.

One may resort to qualitative indicators which may be easily recalled or self assessment of the extent of decline of consumption. In addition, there may be recall based data on consumption of major items/groups of items. Questions on the extent of decline/increase in consumption of these items may provide a basis of comparison even if it does not provide estimates of poverty based on standard methodology. Indicators used in the international multi-indicator poverty assessment method may be taken into account in this context.

Organisational issues

A comprehensive plan for data generation on "Pandemic and its impact on health, economy and society" should be adopted. The major responsibilities will of course be with the national statistical organisation, BBS. Nonetheless, large surveys may not be able to go sufficiently in-depth and therefore cannot be a substitute for small and micro surveys.

The government has taken up projects to improve the skills and technologies in the leather sector and allowed the export of rawhide and wet blue to create demand for the items

While presenting a keynote paper, MA Razzaque, research director of the Policy Research Institute of Bangladesh, said global production of footwears reached \$24.3 billion pairs in 2019.

India has a share of 12 per cent of the global production, of which 95 per cent is for domestic consumption.

Bangladesh produces 380 million pairs of shoes annually. With rising GDP, the domestic market is also expanding. But the domestic market is protected by tariffs, Razzaque said.

Abu Eusuf, a professor of the Development Studies of the University of Dhaka, in his keynote paper, said almost 85 per cent of the raw materials required for the industries are sourced from the domestic markets.

Around 20 per cent of the population buys shoes worth \$50 on average every year and the percentage of the users is

increasing, he said.

Mohiuddin Ahmed Mahin, president of the Bangladesh Finished Leather, Leather Goods and Footwear Exporters Association, said many of the tanneries have become defaulters because of the bank borrowing over the years.

Many could not do well in business because of the slow progress of the CETP. However, nobody is taking the responsibility of the slow progress of the CETP, he said.

Shaheen Ahmed, chairman of the Bangladesh Tanners Association, said the export of leather declined significantly because of low demand from international buyers due to the Covid-19.

The question raised about the capacity of the CETP as the environmental pollution could not be stopped at the STIE, he said.

Every year, 70,000 tonnes of solid waste is produced at the STIE, he said, adding the government needs to manage the waste to protect the environment. Asia Foundation Country Representative

Kazi Faisal Bin Seraj, ERF President Saif Islam Dilal and General Secretary SM Rashidul Islam also spoke.

## Raw jute prices soar to record high

"Farmers will feel encouraged to produce more if high prices persist," said Quayyum.

Jute millers, however, said prices of raw jute should be kept steady to prevent the closure of mills, which employ nearly two lakh workers.

In the letter to the prime minister, millers said farmers would be deprived of prices if mills were to shut down for a shortage of raw materials resulting from higher prices.

"It has come to notice that stockists have stored raw jute to make high profit. If the trend

continues, many mills may shut down," said Progress International, an exporter and the letter signed by BJSA and BJMA chairmen Md Zahid Miah and Mohammed Mahbubur Rahman Patwari.

Both the associations urged the government to stop traders without licences from taking part in raw jute trading.

They also demanded that the government ensure that authorised jute traders and stockists do not hold more than 1,000 maunds of raw jute for over one month.

Md Shahid Hossain Dulal, owner of

supplier of raw jute to mills, said most of the raw jute were now under the possession of

middlemen. "It is a huge crisis in the jute market. Prices of all categories of jute have gone up to extremely high levels. Jute is there and one can get it if he

pays the price sought by traders," he said. Contacted over the phone, Textiles and Jute Secretary Lokman Hossain Miah did not want to comment on the soaring prices and opposing stance of raw jute exporters and millers.

### Export readiness fund seeks applications for grants

Under Window 2, the maximum grant size is \$40,000 and it would be used to improve in business and technical services. 40 per cent of the project cost would have to come from the firms.

The Window 3 would provide up to \$200,000 and will cover the improvement projects in both services and fixed asset expenditures, with half coming from the entrepreneurs.

The fund will be rolled out at a virtual programme

The new windows will support the up-gradation of production plants, equipment, and services and help improve the design and quality of products so they are ready for export. They will also support marketing and distribution to promote ESQ compliance and secure ESQ certification.

Window 1 aims to fund ESQ assessments for 400 companies. It has already signed agreements with 165 companies and is in the process of signing deals with 183 more companies.

Some 230 firms would receive support under Window 2 and another 20 under Window 3.

The ESQ assessment is being carried out by 16 service providers from Bangladesh and other countries under the supervision of UK-based Landell Mills Ltd to find gaps facing the firms, said Azam, also an additional secretary of the commerce ministry.

Thanks to the matching grant, the firms with an export prospect would be able to raise their standard in line with the compliance rules and regulations in the export markets.

The ERF is now rolling out the Window 2 and Window 3 so that firms can get the grants to get ready for exports,

ERF grants are assisting firms to identify and address ESQ compliance gaps, upgrade products and production process and support firms to meet trade standards. This will be done to comply with the laws and regulations of major export markets and requirements of multinational brands, according to the website of the fund, according to an official of the EC4J Project.

The fund will cover three years.

Leather, leather goods and footwear are one of the largest export items of Bangladesh. Overseas shipment from the sector stood at \$797.6 million in the last fiscal year, which is 2.37 per cent of the total exports in the year, data from the Export Promotion Bureau showed.

Exports of plastics and melamine products stood at \$100.52 million.
