specific plans regarding holding and management of HSC exams on Monday or Tuesday," the minister said.

HSC and its equivalent exams slated for April 1 were postponed on March 22 in fear of coronavirus transmission. More than 13 lakh students were expected to take part in the exams.

Dipu Moni said they were earlier considering to give 15 days to students before the exams begin, but they are now considering to give them four weeks.

She said the government will have an alternative mechanism for any students who will not be able to sit for exams due to coronavirus infection.

The government is working on different options regarding the HSC exams, the minister added.

"We are working on a range of possibilities -- how the exams can be held within the shortest possible time, on how many subjects, and on how much marks," Dipu Moni said.

She added that preparing HSC result based on examinees' JSC and SSC results is another option in their consideration. "Some people want evaluation without any exams [HSC] ... the option remains open. We are keeping a range of options open."

The minister said if the government does not hold the exams, this year's HSC candidates can face different unwanted comments from some people as they will be promoted without exams.

Dipu Moni said the mechanism for holding annual exams for class-VI, VII and others at schools will be declared soon.

Talking about some English medium and private schools that are compelling guardians to pay tuition fees at a time when many parents lost their income sources due to the pandemic, the minister said both the school authorities and guardians have to act rationally.

She urged the school authorities to take the fees in instalments and give discounts if possible. She also urged the guardians, who have the ability, to

clear the fees.

"But no students should be disallowed to attend classes for not paying tuition fees," Dipu Moni said.

Educational activities of about four crore students are being hampered due to the coronavirus crisis. This year's Primary Education Completion and its equivalent exams and Junior School Certificate and its equivalent exams were cancelled.

The government started tele education through Sangsad TV for secondary students on March 29, for primary students on April 7, and for technical and madrasa students on April 19 so that students can make up for some of their losses due to closure of the educational institutions.

Deputy Education Minister Mohibul Hassan Chowdhury, Secondary and Higher Education Division Secretary Mahbub Hossain, and Technical and Madrasa Education Division Secretary Aminul Islam Khan also spoke at the programme.

They talked about the government's initiatives for dealing with the coronavirus situation and their work to develop the education sector and ensure quality education.

The thumb can be oriented in three different positions: a tight grip for small objects, a lateral grip for thin objects, and a "power grip" which the researchers say the user can apply to lift heavy objects.

The wrist can also turn, similar to turning a key, meaning that the wearer can hold items in various orientations.

Its 1300mAh battery gives the prosthetic a day of standard use, and will be durable for one year.

The hand is available in two sizes, for either right- or left-handed men and women.

The researchers say that after a training period of under one week, patients could use Hanes in their home to perform daily tasks.

The findings were published in the journal Science Robotics.

At one point an exasperated Biden, who leads strongly in the polls, turned to Trump and said: "Will you shut up, man!"

Trump went as hard on 77-year-old Biden as he'd threatened, saying the "radical left" had the centrist Democrat "wrapped around their little finger."

And he got personal, seeking to rile the former vice president by accusing one of his sons of corruption, and telling Biden that "there's nothing smart" about him.

Biden, though, not only gave as good as he got -- he launched the kind of attack on Trump the billionaire president has rarely had to endure to his face.

"Liar," "racist" and "clown" were just some of the missiles launched from Biden, who also branded Trump the "puppy" of Russian President Vladimir Putin.

Biden has held a modest but steady lead in national voter surveys for months although opinion polls in the battleground states that traditionally decide elections show a closer contest.

The debate appeared unlikely to significantly alter the campaign's dynamics.

Trump has two more debates with Biden scheduled for October, while Vice President Mike Pence and Biden's vice presidential running mate, Kamala Harris, have a debate next week.

Asked by Wallace whether they pledged to urge calm and refrain from declaring victory if the results are not immediately known November 3, Biden said: "Yes."

Trump, though, wouldn't commit, saying that if he saw "tens of thousands of ballots being manipulated, I can't go along with that."

A day after the debate, Biden said voters and agencies "will not stand for it" if Trump refuses to leave office.

The Democrat also denounced a right-wing group that Trump mentioned in the debate, saying: "My message to the Proud Boys and every other white supremacist group is: cease and desist."

Ex-MP Awal saw his property grow

Md Ali Akbar, deputy director of the ACC, yesterday filed a case against Awal, who was elected lawmaker of Pirojpur-1 in 2008 and 2014, for illegally amassing Tk 33 crore.

Another case was filed against Laila for illegally amassing Tk 10.98 crore. The Daily Star obtained copies of First Information Reports.

Analysing the case statement, it was found that before 2008's election, Awal's immovable property worth about Tk 17.33 lakh.

Between 2008 and 2019, he bought land and flats in many places, including Pirojpur, Dhaka, Gazipur and Khulna. The price of these immovable property stands at Tk 6.86 crore.

He has a 2,535 sq ft flat in Sher-e-Bangla Nagar worth around Tk 71.3 lakh, an 8.25 decimal land in Baunia worth Tk 13.25 lakh, a Rajuk plot worth Tk 33.2 lakh and a 4.54 decimal land worth Tk 60 lakh.

Of the Tk 6.86 crore, Awal in his income tax return file showed Tk 3.62 crore immovable property in his son's

and daughter's names, though the sibling declared of having no savings after bearing family expenses.

"It appears that the immovable property actually belonged to Awal," read the FIR.

The ACC in its investigation found Awal's legal source of income would be only Tk 26.69 lakh but he amassed Tk 33.54 crore.

Therefore, he amassed about Tk 33.27 crore beyond the known source of income, reads the FIR.

Of the illegal wealth, the lawmaker concealed information of about Tk 11.06 crore deposited at different banks under different schemes.

His wife Laila owned land worth around Tk 5.14 lakh before 2008.

On September 15, 2011, Laila built a six-storey building in Mohammadpur at Tk 1.2 crore.

She bought a 1,963 flat in 2017 in Badda at Tk 57 lakh.

In her income tax return file, Laila mentioned herself to be involved in a construction business. "But in the investigation, it [the business] was found to be non-existent," read the FIR.

"While her husband was a lawmaker in two terms -- 2008 and 2014 -- she amassed about Tk 11.05 crore moveable and immovable property," it reads.

Her legal income was found to be Tk 6.71 lakh from agricultural projects. "Amassing Tk 10.98 crore beyond the known source of income, Laila committed an offence," according to the FIR.

On December 30, 2019, the ACC filed three separate cases against Awal and Laila for misappropriating government land.

The former lawmaker took lease of government land using fake documents and built a three-storey building on it, which was later rented out to Pirojpur Rural Electricity Cooperative at the rate of Tk 17,250 per month since October 1, 2017, for about three years.

In the second case, Awal was accused of illegally grabbing a government land near Swarupkathi upazila.

In the third case, he was accused of grabbing a 44 decimal pond in Pirojpur town.

Dhaka outraged by Myanmar's

Bangladesh also pointed out that Myanmar made "concocted and misleading" statements on the development in Rakhine State, particularly regarding the repatriation process.

NOT A BILATERAL ISSUE
Myanmar Minister Kyaw Tint Swe, in his speech at the UNGA, on Tuesday said bilateral cooperation was the only way to effectively resolve the Rohingya repatriation issue between Bangladesh and Myanmar.

Bangladesh strongly disagreed on such a notion reminding Myanmar that the Rohingya issue was not a bilateral one, but it was Myanmar's internal problem.

Bangladesh highlighted Myanmar's track record of inhumane treatment of ethnic minorities, including Rohingyas,

saying it was nothing new for Myanmar.

Bangladesh said it was Myanmar's state policy of deliberate exclusion and persecution on their own people that instigated insurgency and turned Myanmar into a breeding ground of organised crimes.

Bangladesh took the floor to respond to Myanmar's "propaganda" and said a deadly conflict was going on in Rakhine State ignoring the UN call for ceasefire simply to implement Myanmar's "genocidal campaign" against its own people, said the official.

Bangladesh provided temporary shelter to over 1.1 million forcibly displaced Myanmar nationals. More than three years have elapsed, but not a single Rohingya could be repatriated.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina in her speech at the 75th UNGA said, "The problem was created by Myanmar

and its solution must be found in Myanmar. I request the international community to play a more effective role for a solution to the crisis."

During the general debate, Bangladesh said the conditions in Rakhine were so bad that not a single Rohingya wanted to return to Myanmar voluntarily.

Bangladesh called upon Myanmar to open Rakhine to international organisations, UN and media to observe the situation on the ground.

Officials said Myanmar's "unsubstantiated claims and undue accusations" against Bangladesh were part of their efforts to avoid their obligations for Rohingya repatriation.

Bangladesh made it clear in the general debate that Myanmar has no intention to implement the repatriation deal signed with Bangladesh.

Man dies in police custody

stimulated at the police station. Masud got a bad head wound there."

He was immediately taken to Rajarbagh Police Lines Hospital and then to Dhaka Medical College Hospital where he was declared dead around 11:00pm, the police officials claimed.

Asked, the police official could not say whether there was any other case filed against Masud previously.

The victim's friend Momin, 36, was also detained with him. Paltan police filed a narcotics case against him.

The Daily Star repeatedly called several police officials of Motijheel Division over phone, including those of Paltan Police Station, for comments, but no one responded.

The victim's wife Rehana Akhter told reporters at DMCH that the police informed on her mobile phone on Tuesday night that Masud was at Paltan Police Station. She was later informed that Masud died.

"I spoke to him at 10:00am [on Tuesday] when he was at the factory for work. Police are saying that they detained him from Gulistan. How did he go there? Police are lying about his death," the victim's wife said.

She added that Masud was earlier detained some 10 years back for taking drugs. After staying in custody for two days, he came out.

"Since then I have only seen him smoking cigarettes. But I don't know if he was used to any drugs," Rehana said, adding that her husband didn't peddle drugs.

The family was at the police station from night till noon. Police also showed Masud's family members footage of the incident.

The incident took place a day after a murder suspect, 25, died in the custody at Bagerhat Police Bureau of Investigation during interrogation on Monday afternoon.
