. The court also set a deadline for The Gambia's memorial submission on October 23 this year, while Myanmar's date for submission was set on July 23, 2021.

The Netherland's letter assuring its determination to support the Gambia's case ahead of its submission of the memorial is significant, said a diplomatic source in Dhaka.

The Netherlands has a tradition of dealing with international law and working against international crimes. Therefore, the country has taken a strong position against the genocidal acts by Myanmar," the source said.

During the call on, Harry Verweij

also assured the Bangladesh foreign minister of continuing humanitarian assistance for some one million Rohingyas living in the camps in Cox's Bazar. He stressed on justice and accountability for a sustainable solution to the Rohingya crisis.

Momen said Bangladesh was focusing on safe and sustainable repatriation of Rohingyas.

He requested the Netherlands to coordinate with the European Union member countries and create a conducive environment back in Rakhine state for the return of Rohingyas.

The report added that 1,767 women and 872 children were new victims of violence.

Covid cases top

In Belgium, where hospitalisations rose 100 percent in just the last week, bars and restaurants were closed vesterday for a month and a curfew will be reinforced overnight.

"Managers, chefs, dish-washers, everyone is suffering," Angelo Bussi said as he put the key in the lock of his Brussels restaurant late Sunday.

"We don't feel like anyone cares. It breaks my heart," he told AFP before shrugging and walking off into the night. "Ah, well there we are, see you in a month.'

Belgium's second major lockdown comes after Prime Minister Alexander de Croo warned the situation was "much worse" than in March when there was an almost complete confinement.

Italy, the initial epicentre of Europe's outbreak, also announced fresh curbs including earlier closures for bars and restaurants and a push to increase working from home.
"We cannot waste time," Prime

Minister Giuseppe Conte said, also flagging bans on amateur team sports and local festivals.

In Poland, where around half the country is now designated as a coronavirus "red zone", the government said the national stadium would double as a field hospital to help ease the strain on overwhelmed health care facilities.

Switzerland meanwhile made mask-wearing compulsory in indoor public spaces and put limits on public gatherings after infections doubled over the last week.

"The second wave is here, earlier

are prepared," Swiss Health Minister Alain Berset said.

France imposed its own overnight curfew from the weekend in nine cities including Paris, affecting 20 million people, with a record 32,400 new infections reported on Saturday.

About 6 million more people in the United Kingdom will face tougher lockdowns in coming days as Wales and Manchester, the country's third largest city, mull additional restrictions as the outbreak accelerates.

Wales First Minister Drakeford yesterday announced that the country would impose a full "firebreak" lockdown for two weeks from Friday in a bid to reduce soaring coronavirus cases.

In England, about 28 million people -- half of the population - have been already subjected to tight social restrictions.

Meanwhile, Slovenia declared a 30-day state of emergency after cases more than doubled in the past week from the previous week. Austria is limiting gatherings to a maximum of six people indoors and 12 outside.

While European nations imposed new restrictions, a lockdown as eased in Austalia's second-biggest city of Melbourne yesterday, as residents flocked to reopened hair salons and golf courses that had been closed for more than 100 days.

The number of daily cases rose to 700 in August in the state of Victoria of which Melbourne is the capital, but following months of a strict lockdown it has fallen as low as one, with four and stronger than we expected, but we recorded yesterday.

\$14M SWEDISH AID FOR BANGLADESH

The government of Sweden has fixed an indicative planning target of 14 million dollars for Bangladesh for the fiscal year 1973-74. This is disclosed by Gus Edgren, leader of the eightmember delegation of the Swedish International Development Authority, now visiting Bangladesh. He says that the Swedish government gave 21 million dollars to Bangladesh under an agreement signed in April, 1972 for the current fiscal year which has already been placed at the disposal of the Bangladesh government for national reconstruction and development. "I know all those who abducted me. I gave their names to police," he said, adding that he would file a case with the police station after being treated at the hospital.

Dr Moktarul Islam Selim, a resident medical officer (RMO) of Rowmari upazila health complex, said the victim had suffered injuries to various parts of his body, including hands and feet.

Contacted, SI Tuhin Mia said Farid was supposed to meet him on Saturday

Murder case plaintiff night, the day of the incident, but he

did not come. After hearing of the incident on Sunday morning, the SI went to the hospital, met Farid and heard about

his abduction in detail, he said. Rowmari Police Station Officer-incharge Abu Md Dilwar Hasan Inam said legal action would be taken if a complaint is filed with the police station in this regard.

Farid's father Rafiqul Islam was murdered over a land dispute at Char Baraikandi village of Rowmari upazila around noon on May 13 this year. He lodged a murder case with Rowmari Police Station accusing 10 persons on the same day.

The accused in the murder case are Mukul Mia,45, Abul Hossain, 50, Shakhawat Hossain, 38, Saidur Rahman, 32, their father Naibar Ali, 80, Saiful Islam, 28, Asad Ali, 27, Rasedul Islam, 25, Ashraful Islam, 18, their parents Abul Hossain and Sabiya Begum, 48. All are of the same residence at Baraikandi village.

OC Dilwar Hasan Inam said the main accused Mukul Mia was arrested and is now in jail. Sabiya Begum got bail from the court, while the eight other accused are absconding.

Early voting begins

The state's prize of 29 electoral votes is tied with New York for third most, behind only California and Texas, in the race for the 270 Electoral College votes that determine the presidential winner under the US system.

The Oct 7-14 Reuters/Ipsos poll showed Biden with 49% of the support and Trump 47%, within the survey's credibility interval of 4 percentage points.

Both campaigns have poured advertising money into Florida, although Biden, who has significantly outraised Trump since the summer while setting consecutive monthly records for a US candidate, has outspent his Republican rival.

Harris, who was given a clean bill of health after an aide tested positive for Covid-19, will participate in early-vote rallies in Orlando and Jacksonville, the campaign said.

Trump will stage rallies first in Prescott and later in Tucson, Arizona, another state for which both his campaign and Biden's are competing.

The 27.9 million Americans who have already voted either by mail or in person, according to the US Elections Project at the University of Florida, is a far greater number at this point in the campaign than previous years. Voters have now cast about 20% of the overall total in 2016, when more than 136.6 million cast ballots.

Democrats account for 55% of

the 10.9 million ballots cast in states that report party registration data, compared with 24% for Republicans.

At a rally in Carson City, Nevada on Sunday, where voting began the day before, Trump implored his supporters to "get out and vote" to help him flip a state that he lost narrowly to Democratic nominee Hillary Clinton in 2016.

Despite his recent recovery from his own bout with the virus, Trump also mocked Biden in Nevada for his cautious approach toward the pandemic.

"Listen to the scientists!" Trump said in a mocking voice. "If I listened totally to the scientists, we would right now have a country that would be in a massive depression."

Trump also lashed out at "stupid" critics from within his own party and called for unity after growing Republican criticism and warnings of a "bloodbath" in the November 3 election.

He particularly attacked Republican Senator Ben Sasse of Nebraska, who recently told his constituents that Trump "kisses dictators' butts," mistreats women and uses the White House as a business.

Other Republicans have warned of electoral losses in the polls, including
