200 families in Sharsha barely survive on selling snails

At least 200 poverty-stricken families, many of whom were fishers by profession, in Sharsha upazila of Jashore have resorted to catching snails for survival in the past few months.

Many of the residents, of eleven unions in the upazila, said efforts are being made to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic and some of them lost their access to fishing in local water bodies such as Banmandar Beel.

Shankar Mandal, inhabitant of fishing village Tebaria in Dihi union, said they used to live on catching fish in Banmandar Beel, an open water body in the area.

After their entry to the wetland was restricted by a private fish farm, many of the villagers were forced to leave their ancestral profession and start scavenging open water bodies -- local rivers, canals, ponds and wetlands -- for snails.

They scour the area all day for snails and make a stockpile of those in the village in the afternoon.

Now he and his family members are struggling to survive on earnings from selling snails for only Tk 5 each kilogram. "On an average day, I get about 60 to 70 kilograms of snails," Shankar added.

The poor families are worried as to how long they would survive on the meagre

income from gathering snail, which is available in the nature for only several months -- Ashar through Kartik of the Bangla calendar year.

Another cause for concern is that a large number of the snail gatherers are contracting skin diseases as toxicity is unusually high in the local water bodies this year, they said.

Pakshiya village resident Rajab Ali said he and his family members head out in the morning and continue to gather snails from the locality till around 3:00pm.

The family has to live on an income of around Tk 250 to Tk 300, from 50 to 60 kg of snails that they are able to gather in an entire day, he also said.

Sarani, who comes from family of fishers in fishing village Gorpara, said the water in the local water bodies this year is causing severe skin diseases. But, poor people like her, who have no skill for other jobs, have no other choice but to go in the water and gather snails every day.

Snail trader Akram Hossain, from Wapda Khalpara area, said snail is an ingredient of fish feed consumed at different shrimp enclosures and fish farms.

He also said that he buys about 65 to 70 maunds of snail from the gatherers every day and sells those to a buyer at Kapalia Bridge Bazar in Dumuria of Khulna.

Neelima Point: An oasis by the Bay

The flood protection embankment of the Bishkhali river, which flows through the southern part of Patharghata town in Barguna, is gaining popularity among tourists.

Located near the river's mouth at Bay of Bengal, the spot on the embankment has been named Neelima Point, which has been formally inaugurated by Barguna district administration recently.

The place was given the name 'Neelima' because when the Bishkhali river meets the turquoise waters of the Bay -- with the blue sky embracing them above -- the nature there wears a blue attire.

The place sees a good crowd in the afternoon when clean air, tranquil waters of the Bay and natural greenery on both sides of the river's banks become too irresistible for visitors.

Neelima Point came into being after the Patharghata town protection levee, built to save the town from strong current of the Bishkhali, was renovated and fortified with concrete blocks recently.

People of all ages and professions oftentimes stay at Neelima Point till the evening when they can reenergise by observing the breathtaking view of the rising moon in the east.

Nripendra Nath Sadhak, a retired teacher of Bangla at Patharghata

College, said he enjoys visiting this southern part of the town where there are many trees in the pastures along high slopes of the Bishkhali river.

Tourism has immense potential there, as the serenity of the Bay and blue sky above helps one find inner peace, he added.

Patharghata Upazila Nirbahi Officer Humayun Kabir said the upazila has good potential for tourism and Neelima Point is a good place for people to spend time near Patharghata town.

He also said the site needs further

development in order to provide necessary amenities for tourists.

Mostafa Golam Kabir, chairman of the upazila, said efforts are being made to make Neelima Point an attractive destination for residents of the town.

Contacted, Barguna Deputy Commissioner Mustain Billah said emphasis would be placed on the tourism potential of the picturesque Neelima Point.

Aside from adding more facilities and services for visitors, security would be heightened around the area for their protection as well, he added.





Poacher jailed, 32 dead birds seized

Members of Forest and Nature Conservation Department in a drive detained four people, including three minor boys, and seized at least 32 dead birds from them in Habiganj's Chunarughat upazila on Monday evening.

A mobile court later sentenced the adult bird hunter, out of the four, to one month imprisonment under Wildlife Conservation Act, Chunarughat Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Satyajit Ray Das said.

The convict, Siddique Ali, 31, is a resident of Chandpur area in the upazila.

However, the three minor poachers were released upon giving an undertaking that they would never involve in such illegal activities in future, he added.

UNO Satyajit said officials of Chunarughat Forest and Nature Conservation Department detained the four when Siddique Ali and the three minor boys were taking the dead birds in Chandpur Tea Garden for sale.
