Water hyacinth invasion renders Boro farmers jobless



The invasion of water hyacinth on 500 bighas of cropland, in Jatarpur and Shahshree areas of Hail Haor under Srimangal upazila, has left thousands of farmers jobless for two years.

thousand farmers, whose livelihoods depend on Boro cultivation, have plunged into abject poverty over the last couple of years due to accumulation of water hyacinth on about 500 bighas of cropland in Srimangal upazila's Jatarpur and Shahshree areas of Hail Haor.

For survival, many of the farmers and their family members have been relying on meagre income from working as day labourers in Srimangal town or catching fish in the area.

The free-floating aquatic plant started to accumulate on the low-lying cropland, suitable for cultivation of Boro rice, in between the Gofla river and the damaged section of the river's western embankment, said the farmers.

Heaps of water hyacinth is getting stuck in Shahshree as well as Jatarpur villages while floating towards the breached parts of the embankment behind, said Bimal Das, a farmer from Shahshree village, while talking to this correspondent.

The aggregation of the invasive plant over the past two years has turned the land uncultivable for thousands of local farmers,

Abdul Gaffar, another farmer from the same area, said the damaged embankment on the river's western bank is one of the reasons why the floating water hyacinth is increasingly being drawn towards their

"We've been growing Boro in this part of Hail Haor for generations. This is our only source of income. But over the last couple of years, we couldn't grow any rice here," said farmer Sadek Mia, from Jatarpur

Jatarpur resident Khursed Ahmed said despite contacting the union parishad and upazila parishad offices numerous times during this time, no steps were taken to remedy the situation. "But without being able to grow rice there, my family is going unfed most of the time."

Acknowledging the situation, Mirzapur Union Parishad Member Mohit Paul said the situation aggravated as the damaged western embankment of the Gofla river has been left unrepaired for around three years.

He also said the union parishad has no resources or capacity in conducting the repair work on the levee. But for the sake of the farmers, it needs to be done urgently.

Srimangal Upazila Agriculture Officer Nilufar Yasmin Monalisa Sweety said after paying a visit to the area, she came to learn that about three thousand farmers are living in misery as they could not grow Boro due to invasion of water hyacinth in the area in the last two years.

Since the farmers are not in the capacity to remove such a huge amount of water hyacinth accumulation from the cropland, she would raise the issue to higher authorities, she added.

Contacted, Upazila Nirbahi Officer Nazrul Islam said he would take necessary steps after making an enquiry over the situation.

Shankar Chakraborty, Ranendra executive engineer of Water Development Board in Moulvibazar, said once they receive a petition from locals, seeking a solution to the problem, they would prepare a project proposal, incorporating both dredging of the Gofla river and repairing its western embankment at the same time.

Encroachers building structures on 3 govt ponds

Three government ponds on about three acres of land at Mohipur Bazar in Kalapara upazila are allegedly being grabbed by a section of local influential people.

Apart from this, locals are throwing waste in the ponds, polluting waters there, said some residents of the area.

As a result, the ponds now turn into breeding grounds of mosquitoes, they

Although Mohipur union land office prepared a list of 52 grabbers in August last year and sent it to the office of assistant commissioner (land) in the upazila, the encroachment has been going on openly as the authorities concerned failed to take any action against the encroachers.

According to the union land office, the three government ponds named Kalibari Pukur-I, Kalibari Pukur-2 and Kacharibari Pukur lie at Mohipur Bazar, a fish landing station near Kuakata sea beach. There are 10,000 business establishments and dwelling ponds. houses in the area.

alleged occupier Md Nurul Haq, hung at a tin-shed house on a pond. The construction workers in the house were working to build a permanent

Nurul Haq said two years ago, he bought a piece of land from another local person named Md Selim at a cost of Tk 4 lakh. He made an oral contract with Selim while purchasing the land from the latter.

"I am now trying to get a DCR (duplicate carbon receipt) from the local land office," he said.

Despite repeated attempts, this correspondent could not reach another alleged grabber Md Sahid, also the partner of Nurul Haq, for his comment on the issue as he did not receive the phone calls. Sub-assistant land officer Azizur

Rahman said they also sent the list of encroachers to Kalapara upazila nirbahi office for seeking lawful steps. But no instruction came from there.

Contacted, Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Md Munibur Rahman said they got the list. They will conduct a drive there soon to demolish all illegal structures.

Clash leaves 8 injured

At least eight people were injured and 50 vehicles vandalized when a clash erupted between the drivers of CNG-run auto-rickshaws and battery-run easybikes in Kulaura upazila headquarters yesterday.

The injured are Lutfur Rahman, 50, Maram Ali, 40, Nowshad, 28, Badrul, 30, Jabbar, 32, Fakhrul, 21, and Faisal, 30.

Of them, Lutfur was rushed to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital, following deterioration of his condition.

Locals said CNGrun auto drivers called a strike in Kulaura upazila yesterday, demanding an end to plying of batterypowered easy-bikes.

As part of their protest, they took position at various points of the municipal town yesterday.

The clash erupted between the two groups when easy-bike drivers also took to the streets in the afternoon that left at least eight people from both sides injured.

Battery-run Autorickshaw Workers' Association President Akash Ahmed claimed that CNG-run auto drivers vandalized 30 to 35 batteryrun vehicles and their office during the clash.

Meanwhile, Sohag Mia, general secretary of CNG Auto-rickshaw Workers' Union, said about 15 to 16 CNG-run vehicles were vandalized by the opposition group.
