His father Sunil Kumar Paul serves as a head teacher at Kurma Tea Garden Non-Government Primary School for a meagre monthly wage of Tk 1,200. Along with mother Rina Rani Paul, they live in the tea garden under Kamalganj upazila of Moulvibazar.

Doctors recommended the family to take immediate steps to treat Laxikanto, but it could cost around Tk 14 lakh. "It is not possible for us to bear the expenses alone," said Sunil, himself a stroke patient. To add to their woes, Sunil's mother is a cancer patient.

DU alumni to honour Prof Ataharul Islam

Dhaka University Statistics Department Alumni Association (DUSDA) has decided to award Dr M Ataharul Islam with its highest accolade, "DUSDA Outstanding Leadership Award", said a press release.



Dr Ataharul, a renowned academic, was a former student of Dhaka University's (DU) Department of Statistics. In his four decades of teaching, he has worked at several universities around the world, including University of Hawaii, University of Pennsylvania, University of Alabama and King Saud University.

He also taught at Dhaka University, Chittagong University and East West University. In addition, he has more than 200 research articles in international journals. He also has five books to his credit, all published abroad.

He was a trendsetter in DU's Department of Statistics in terms of research, the press release said.

Apart from his contribution to DU, he has played a significant role in the development of statistics curriculum of many universities, both home and abroad, and policy analysis for various government and non-government organisations and development partners.

DUSDA is set to host a virtual award giving ceremony on November 26, where DU VC Prof M Akhtaruzzaman will serve as chief guest, and ex-JU VC Prof Kazi Saleh Ahmed will be special guest.

hopeful of settling the issue soon. "We've already held the tripartite meeting and asked the project sponsor to provide a detailed analysis of the tariff offered for the project."

Earlier DPDC had unsuccessfully tried to pursue different government agencies, including the Food Directorate, the Shilpakala Academy, the Women and Children Directorate, and the Education Directorate, for using their rooftops for the project, but none agreed.

Officials said DPDC has initiated the move for solar power projects as part of the government plan to generate 10 percent electricity from solar power by 2020 to promote renewable energy across the country. The country's solar power generation still remains below 450 MW, while the total power generation capacity is about 23,000 MW, the officials said.

Sakib, who developed the idea of Circular, said, "Waste pickers are some of the most neglected and marginalised people of our society. However, they are the warriors who deal with all types of waste. installed within this month and the last two would be installed within mid-December," Bridge Division Secretary Belayet Hossain said.

"With the installation of all spans, a major work for the bridge would be completed," he told The Daily Star yesterday.

Replying to a question, he said, "It would take 12 to 14 months to complete all works. It may be opened [for public] in the first half of 2022."

Belayet Hossain said railway stringers and roadway decks are being installed now and some others works including installation of electricity

and gas lines have to be completed before opening the bridge for public.

He said the railway stringers, which went into the Padma due to erosion at a yard, has to be brought from Luxemburg and this is causing some delay.

The current deadline of the project is June 2021 and they have to take approval for extending it, he added.

When works of most development projects was suspended due to the pandemic, Padma Multipurpose Bridge Project work continued.

But it suffered due to a shortage of workers -- Chinese and local -- and poor supply of construction materials since January, said officials involved

with the project.

The project authority was able to bring back pace after Chinese nationals returned to work in May following the end of the two-month shutdown.

However, strong currents in the Padma river started causing problems to that end, they said.

No span could not be installed between June 10 and October 11, due to strong currents, officials said.

Besides, at least 192 railway stringers and 220 roadway decks, supposed to be installed for construction of the bridge, went into the Padma on July 31 due to erosion at a yard.
