Turkish ship leaves disputed waters in east Med

A Turkish research ship at the centre of a row with Greece over potential gas riches in the eastern Mediterranean has returned to port, Turkey's energy ministry said yesterday.

The Oruc Reis seismic survey vesse has become a symbol of Turkey's growing appetite to find natural gas in the contested waters despite opposition by Greece and Cyprus.

Backed by Turkish navy frigates, the ship was first deployed in August and again in October to the waters south of Greece's Kastellorizo island, in defiance of calls to stop by the European Union and the United States.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina oined the cabinet meeting virtually from the Gono Bhaban. The health ministry apprised the update on

vaccine procurement at the meeting. Apart from the vaccine from SII, Bangladesh will buy 68 million doses from the Gavi under a global arrangement called COVAX. The first shipment of vaccine doses from Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance, is likely to be made between February and June next year, said officials of the health directorate

Each person will need two doses. The cost of each shot has been estimated at \$1.62 to \$2.

However, the government would pay \$5 for each dose from Serum once the vaccine is approved for human application. The three crore doses will be delivered in phases with 50 lakh doses every month.

Asked about the high price of the vaccine from Serum, Anwarul said the procurement contract was yet to be done. "It's too early to make any comment."

Besides, the health ministry is also in talks with some other manufacturers for vaccines, he added.

Asked what would happen if there was any irregularity in the distribution of the vaccine, Anwarul said, "If anyone commits corruption, let us know and we will take action.

"Following the WHO Protocol is our primary condition to the manufacturers. Even an existing contract can be cancelled, if there is any major deviation from WHO guidelines.

In India, a 40-year-old volunteer for the candidate vaccine of Serum, sued the company for Rs 5 crore, alleging that the vaccine triggered an adverse reaction, which includes neurological impairment and an inability to get back to life before being inoculated, according to media reports.

He demanded, via a legal notice sent to the Serum, AstraZeneca and the Oxford Vaccine Group, that the vaccine trial, which is now being tested on 1,600 volunteers in India, be

Human ageing reversed old, malfunctioning senescent cells. A clinical trial involving 35 adults over the age of 64 sought to understand whether a method called Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy could prevent the deterioration of these two hallmarks of the ageing The subjects were placed in a pressurised chamber and given pure oxygen for 90 minutes a day, five days a week for three months. At the end of the trial, the scientists reported that the participants' telomeres had increased in length by an average of 20 percent, while their senescent cells had been reduced by up to 37 percent.

This is the equivalent to how their bodies were at a cellular level 25 years earlier, the researchers reported.

"Since telomere shortening is considered the 'Holy Grail' of the biology of ageing, many pharmacological and environmental interventions are being extensively explored in the hopes of enabling telomere elongation,' said Shai Efrati, a professor at the Faculty of Medicine and Sagol School of Neuroscience at Tel Aviv University, and co-author of the study.

"The significant improvement of telomere length shown during and after these unique HBOT protocols provides the scientific community with a new foundation of understanding that ageing can, indeed, be targeted and reversed at the basic cellular-biological level

It is the latest in a series of radical anti-ageing treatments, which seek to increase life expectancy and even make people look and feel younger.

The idea is that ageing is a disease that can be cured just like any other.
