Meanwhile, the HC bench also ordered the health secretary and director general of DGHS to submit a revised chart of other medical tests and a report on the progress of a health commission formation within a month.
The court fixed January 20, 2021 as the date for further hearing and passing order on this issue, petitioner's lawyer Bashir Ahmed told The Daily Star.
According to the revised chart prepared by the DGHS, CBC test would cost Tk 500, CRP test Tk 600, LFT test Tk 1,000, S Creatim test Tk 800, S Electrolgle test Tk 1,000, D Dimer test Tk 1,500, S Ferrition test Tk 1,200, S Procalcitonin test Tk 2,000, CT Scan-Chest test Tk 6,000, Cht x-ray-Analogue Tk 400, and Cht x-ray-Digital Tk 600.
Once the price chart is displayed at the gates of hospitals, clinics and diagnostic centres, people would not have to pay extra money, the petitioner's lawyer said.
Assistant Attorney General Kalipado Mridha represented the state during the court proceedings.
During hearing the writ petition, the HC bench on September 1 sought the revised charts of fees and charges for medical tests at private clinics, hospitals and diagnostic centres.
Following the same writ petition, the HC on July 24, 2018 had directed that private clinics, hospitals and diagnostic centres to display the charts of their charges and fees in public view.
Health secretary, director general of the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) and Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council had been asked to execute the directives.

Prof ABM Khurshid Alam, director general of the DGHS, signed the agreement on behalf of the government and Nazmul Hasan Papon, managing director of Beximco Pharmaceuticals Ltd, on behalf of the mediator company.
The contract paper will be sent to the Serum Institute of India (SII) for producer's authorisation.
Among others, Prof Nasima Sultana, additional director general (administration) of the DGHS, was also present there.
On November 5, the health ministry signed a tri-lateral memorandum of understanding (MoU) with Beximco and SII to purchase three crore doses of Oxford-AstraZeneca's vaccine.
Against this backdrop, the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs on December 2 approved in principle a proposal of the Health Services Division to procure Covid-19 vaccine directly from any organisation through

On July 16, Masud, Babu along with some others took her away in a CNG-run auto-rickshaw after the girl reached Bogura's Mohishura area on her way to her grandmother's home in the nearby district of Sirajganj, said her father.
As the parents went to Dhunat Police Station to file an abduction case, Ahsanul Haque, one of the sub-inspectors, allegedly rebuked them and showed them the door.
Police finally registered the abduction case on August 12, filed by the girl's mother against Masud, Babu, and five others of the same village.
The girl was found unconscious with her hands and feet tied with rope in Kazipur upazila of Sirajganj on August 24. Locals informed her parents and Dhunat police brought her home from the spot.
According to her mother, the girl told police that Masud Rana and UP member Fazlul Haque Babu abducted her, locked her up in a room andrepeatedly raped her for 38 days. Most of the time she was given sleeping pills.
Talking to The Daily Star on Saturday, the victim said, "Masud Rana and Fazlul Haque Babu abducted me and raped over a month. They ruined my life. I want their exemplary punishment so that they can't spoil any other girl's life."
Police sent the girl for medical tests and received the results on October 25.
"We found primary evidence of rape in her medical test," said Kripa Sindhu Bala, officer-in-charge of Dhunat Police Station, declining to comment further.
Babu was arrested in Bogura town on December 5, said the OC.
'HUMILIATED ENOUGH'
However, more than three and a half months after the girl was abducted, police have still not recorded a rape case even after getting evidence of rape and the victim's statement that she was gang-raped.
In what is a grim and familiar

Pune-based Serum has an agreement with AstraZeneca to manufacture the vaccine, ChAdOx1 nCoV-19, being developed by the Oxford University. The vaccine has been branded Covishield in India.
Once the vaccine is approved for human application, Beximco Pharma will buy each dose from Serum for \$4 and then supply it to the government for \$5.
Each person will need two doses.
On November 16, the finance ministry initially allocated some Tk 735.77 crore for the Health Service Division to procure the Covid-19 vaccine.
Apart from the vaccine from SII, Bangladesh will buy 68 million doses from the Gavi under a global arrangement called COVAX. The first shipment of vaccine doses from Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance, is likely to be delivered between February and June next year, health directorate officials said.

NEW DEATHS
Thirty-two more people died from Covid-19 in 24 hours ending at 8:00am yesterday, according to a DGHS press release.
With this, the total number of deaths has now reached 7,052, and the death rate stands at 1.44 percent.
At least 1,355 new infections were recorded during the period, taking the number of people infected to 4,90,533, the release added.
Against a total of 12,748 tests in those 24 hours, the positivity rate was 10.63 percent, while the total positivity rate was 16.52 percent.
Meanwhile, 3,393 Covid-19 patients recovered in the same 24 hours, bringing the number of recoveries to 4,20,896. This was 85.80 percent of all confirmed cases.
Of the 32 deceased, 24 were men and eight women.
One was aged between 21 and 30, one between 41 and 50, three were aged between 31 and 40, seven between 51 and 60, and 20 were above 60 years, added the release.

Hossain Sarkar, also an advisor of the Dhunat Awami League, and Anowar Hossain, former Gopalnagar UP chairman and a local BNP leader, were present.
Others who joined the meeting included Azhar Mukti, Solaiman Ali, Nurul Islam, Sayeed Bapary, Abdul Mannan and Sathi Khatun, said local sources.
From the family, victim's father and elder brother were present.
The village arbitrators decided that Babu and Masud would give the victim's mother Tk 2.5 lakh within a week and she would withdraw the case against them.
At another meeting, Tk 30,000 was handed over to Anowar Hossain to give it to the family. Later, Azhar and Sayeed took the signature of the survivor's mother on an affidavit relating to the agreement over the case withdrawal, said UP Chairman Golam.
The mother, however, said she did not take any money.
Police said they have already arrested three -- Masud's uncle Abdul Mannan, Sayeed Bapary and Sathi Khatun -- who were present at the village arbitration.
Sayeed Bapary admitted taking Tk 1,00,000 from the two accused and handing the amount to other arbitrators, said Additional SP Gaziur Rahman.
Contacted, Golam Hossain Sarkar said, "I was reluctant to attend the meeting, but I went there at the request of the victim's mother and former chairman Anowar Hossain."
Anowar claimed he had attended the meeting at the request of the current chairman. He denied taking any money from the accused.
"Attending the meeting was a mistake, I know that this kind of incident cannot be settled," he added.
Golam Hossain echoed the same.
Additional SP Gaziur said, "We will take action against all who were involved in arranging the arbitration."

HC stays trial proceedings

Khan told The Daily Star that the HC issued the stay order and rule after hearing the argument that Matiur Rahman was not present at the venue where Abrar, a ninth-grader, was electrocuted during the anniversary programme of Prothom Alo's youth magazine Kishor Alo on November 1 last year.
Matiur Rahman was neither involved in electricity supply management for the occasion nor appointment of the contractor for electricity management, and therefore there were no elements for framing charges against him in the case, the lawyer added.
Meanwhile, DAG Saifuddin Khaled told this correspondent that he does not know whether the government will move any appeal before the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court against the stay order.
On November 12 this year, a Dhaka court framed charges against Matiur Rahman and nine others in the case filed over Abrar's death.
The lower court, however, discharged Prothom Alo Deputy Editor Anisul Hoque as it found no grounds to frame charges against him.
The other accused are Kishor Alo Head of Events and Activation Kabir Bakul, the youth magazine's Events and Activation Assistants Shuvashish Pramanik Shuvo and Shah Paran Tushar, its Senior Assistant Editor Mahitul Alam Pavel, and stage decorators Jasim Uddin Topu, Mosharraf Hossain, Md Sujan and Kamrul Hawlader.
Matiur and eight others, now on bail, pleaded not guilty and demanded justice after Judge KM Emrul Kayesh of the Metropolitan Sessions Judge's

Court of Dhaka read out the charges to them.
The court had earlier dismissed five other petitions submitted by their lawyers to discharge them from the case.
The court then fixed December 14 for starting the trial of the case.
Abrar's father Mojibur Rahman filed the case with the Fourth Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court in Dhaka on November 6.
In the complaint, Mojibur said his son was electrocuted and became unconscious around 4:30pm on November 1 while attending the programme.
Dhaka's Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Aminul Haque took the case into cognisance and ordered the OC of Mohammadpur Police Station to submit an investigation report.
On January 16 this year, Abdul Alim, inspector of Mohammadpur Police Station, submitted the probe report to the court, saying the charges brought against all 10 accused were found to be true.
Dhaka's Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Kaisarul Islam issued arrest warrants against Matiur Rahman and nine others in the case that day.
Following the arrest warrants, Matiur Rahman got bail from the High Court while nine others got bails from different lower courts.
On September 20, Dhaka Metropolitan Magistrate Mohammad Jasim ordered that the case be transferred to the Dhaka Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court for trial.
On October 1, the Dhaka Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court took cognisance of the charges against Matiur Rahman and nine others in the case.

US starts vaccination today

new measures agreed by Chancellor Angela Merkel with regional leaders of Germany's 16 states yesterday.
Germany last week recorded new daily death tolls reaching close to 600 and as disease control agency RKI reported that the infections trend has taken a worrying turn.
Italy meanwhile overtook Britain as the European nation with the highest coronavirus death toll.
"I am worried about the two weeks of Christmas holidays. We are up against a dramatic pandemic which is ongoing -- the battle still has not been won," Italian Health Minister Roberto

Speranza warned as the country recorded 64,036 deaths, surpassing Britain's 64,026.
Regional Affairs Minister Francesco Boccia said that unless people adopted a careful approach, "the risk of a third wave is almost certain."
As fatalities worldwide passed 1.6 million, infections in the United States were soaring, with 1.1 million new cases confirmed in the past five days and the death toll nearing 300,000.
Over the past two weeks, the US has repeatedly exceeded 2,000 Covid-related deaths per day, rivaling tolls from the early days of the pandemic.

The infections also prompted factory closures and look set to have an impact on global supply.
Top Glove, which commands about a quarter of the world's market, has warned of delays to deliveries and rising prices.
"DIDN'T KEEP WORKERS SAFE"
More than 5,000 workers -- almost a quarter of the firm's workforce -- have tested positive after the outbreak at an industrial area housing factories and dormitories outside the capital Kuala Lumpur.
"The accommodation is so overcrowded," said the Bangladeshi

worker Kibria.
"The room itself is a bare minimum. It is quite impossible to maintain cleanliness when so many people live in a single room. It is like an army barracks -- only less maintained."
When the situation escalated last month, Top Glove began shifting infected workers to hospital and their close contacts to quarantine centres, reducing the numbers in dormitories.
Kibria, 24, was suspected of having Covid-19 so was first put in hospital, although he later tested negative and was moved to a hotel.
But critics say the actions were too little too late.

date and duration based on a proposal to be submitted by the publishers' association, which will first await ministry approval.
Farid said safety measures for the book fair had already been discussed. Dedicated teams will ensure that visitors and participants wear face masks at all time. Hand sanitisers will be kept at the strategic points. Social distancing and other safety measures will be monitored at the entrances, he said.
Mentioning the ongoing pandemic, the book fair committee on Saturday said the fair will be held virtually in February.
"Plans to host the Amar Ekushey Grantha Mela 2021 at its usual physical location have been suspended due to the Covid-19 pandemic. We have decided to have the fair virtually this year," Jalal Ahmed, member secretary of the book fair committee, had told this paper.
The associations of publishers and booksellers protested the decision and called for an urgent meeting with the Bangla Academy authorities yesterday morning.
"We were surprised to learn that the Bangla Academy had unilaterally decided to suspend preparations for the book fair 50 days before the scheduled date. A virtual book fair can never be an alternative to our historic tradition," the associations of publishers and booksellers stated in a letter sent to member organisations on Saturday.

Fossil hunter finds new type of ‘sea dragon’

Jacobs, who has spent several years working on ichthyosaurs, identified it as a new genus and species which lived 150 million years ago.
Researchers say the discovery is the UK's fifth known ichthyosaur from the Late Jurassic period and by far the smallest so far.
The fossil was found near Kimmeridge Bay - part of the Jurassic Coast World Heritage Site - in a limestone known as the white stone band.
When the ichthyosaur died, the seafloor would have been a very soft ooze, allowing the front half of the animal to sink into the mud before scavengers came along and ate the tail end.
As a result of being buried in this way, it was preserved in exceptional conditions and even some of its soft tissues were preserved.
Jacobs said: "Skeletons of Late Jurassic ichthyosaurs in the UK are extremely rare, so, after doing some research, comparing it with those known from other Late Jurassic deposits around the world and not being able to find a match was very exciting."
"Thalassiodraco etchesi is a beautifully preserved ichthyosaur, with soft tissue preservation making it all the more interesting."
"Steve's incredible collection contains many new and exciting animals and being given the chance to describe this ichthyosaur was a real privilege."
Ichthyosaurs were highly adapted marine predators, with a streamlined body for gliding through the water, large eyes for enhanced vision, and elongated jaws full of conical teeth, well-suited for catching slippery fish and squid.
The newly discovered species has a deep ribcage, small forelimbs and hundreds of tiny, delicate, smooth teeth.
The specimen is on display alongside Dr Etches's other many fossils in his museum in Dorset, the Etches Collection, which he built to house the many discoveries he's made over a lifetime of fossil hunting.

UK, EU agree to go ‘extra mile’

after almost a year of negotiations, despite the fact that deadlines have been missed over and over we think it is responsible at this point to go the extra mile," Johnson and von der Leyen said in a joint statement yesterday.
Britain quit the EU in January but remains an informal member until December 31 - the end of a transition period during which it has remained in the EU single market and customs union.
Britain and the EU are very far apart on key issues in trade talks so people should be prepared for a no-deal on December 31, Johnson said yesterday.
"I'm afraid we're still very far apart on some key things, but where there is life, there's hope, we're going to keep talking to see what we can do. The UK certainly won't be walking away from the talks," Johnson told reporters.
"I've got to repeat the most likely thing now is of course that we have

to get ready for WTO-terms, Australia terms."

A Brexit without a trade deal would damage the economies of Europe, send shockwaves through financial markets, snarl borders and sow chaos through the delicate supply chains across Europe and beyond.

"Every opportunity to reach a deal is highly welcome," German Chancellor Angela Merkel told a news conference in Berlin.

The two sides have struggled to agree on fishing rights in British waters and EU demands that Britain face consequences if in the future it diverges from the bloc's rules for fair competition - what it calls a level playing field.

"They are making some inroads on difficult stuff. How to manage divergence and soften the blows for (EU) fishermen is still open," one EU diplomat said.
