dating back to around 4300 BC.

Prior to the recent discovery, experts had placed the first rice paddies some 3,000 years ago.

Rice is found in a number of cultures around the world, but has been a way of life for the Chinese for thousands of years.

Rice paddies, or wet rice farming, survive in stable conditions that are not too hot or cold.

The fields are flooded to supply water during the growing seasons and without modern technology, harvesting crops by hand is time consuming and grueling

Previous studies have analyzed DNA of ancient rice dating back nearly 2,000 years and compared the results with that of today's.

The findings showed that early humans dined on a variety of rice, instead of the two domesticated varieties, japonica and indica, we consume today.

The latest discovery was announced by the **Zhejiang Provincial** Institute of Cultural Relics and Archaeology and the Ningbo Cultural Heritage Management Research Institute, CGTN reports.

Apart from procuring the cranes, 12 BR engineers would receive onemonth foreign training under the project.

Áround Tk 1 crore would also be spent on procuring transport vehicles for the project.

Now, the proposal would be sent to the Planning Commission for approval and then it would be sent to the Economic Relations Division for managing foreign fund for the project, Project Director Md Burhan

Uddin told The Daily Star yesterday. The 3,018km railway network is covered by the accident relief cranes stationed at 12 sheds in two railway's

Some 91 train accidents took place during 2018-19 fiscal year. Of them, 78 were train derailments and in 10 incidents trains crashed into things, according to railway information book-2019.

After any accident is reported, relief cranes from the nearby shed is called for conducting the rescue operation, but in some cases, the authorities have to call cranes from far away due to lack of capability of nearby cranes, a railway official said

"In many cases, rescue operation takes more than usual time as most of the cranes are outdated," the official, who have long experience in railway operation, told The Daily Star, wishing not to be named.

Burhan Uddin, also the chief mechanical engineer (development), said the addition of three cranes would ensure quick salvage operation after any accident to restore rail communications. About the financing in the project,

he said as per their proposal, 70 percent of the project cost would come from foreign funds and 30 percent from the government funds. Once the PDPP is approved,

they will prepare and submit development project proposal (DPP) for getting approval from the Executive Committee of the National Economic Council (Ecnec) to start impiementation of the project, ne said.

"We hope to add the three cranes to our fleet within the next two years," he said, adding that the cranes would be stationed in Dhaka, Rajbari, and Chattogram.

Court accepts charge sheet

OC Pradeep Kumar Das and suspended inspector Liaqat Ali of

Baharchhara Investigation Centre. Yesterday, the senior judicial magistrate's court also accepted the final reports in two cases, filed by Teknaf police after the murder of Sinha, and cleared lone accused Shahadul Islam Sefat of arms and drug charges. Sinha was killed at an APBn checkpoint on the Cox's Bazar-Teknaf Marine Drive on the night of July 31. Local police said suspended inspector Liagat's team had taken over the check post from three APBn officers before the killing incident.

Sharmin Shahriar Ferdous, elder sister of Sinha, had filed the murder case with a local court on August 5. Later, Rab was tasked with its investigation.

The retired army officer was shooting videos for his YouTube channel in Teknaf's Marishbunia before he was shot. He had been residing in the area for a month for filming.

Top HK court upholds emergency protest mask ban

The Hong Kong government's decision to use a colonial-era emergency law to ban face masks at protests last year was both proportionate and legal, the city's top court ruled yesterday.

The ruling is a blow for democracy supporters who had been hoping the Court of Final Appeal would side with a lower court and overturn the

It also confirms that Hong Kong's chief executive -- a pro-Beijing appointee -- has the power to enact any law in a time of public emergency without needing the approval of the city's partially elected legislature.

But its practical consequences were unclear, given that the government has made masks compulsory in public areas to combat the coronavirus pandemic. Hong Kong was convulsed by seven

straight months of huge and often

violent pro-democracy protests last They were eventually quashed by mass arrests, a virus-related ban on public gatherings and Beijing imposing a new national security law

on the city in June.

In October last year Chief Executive Carrie Lam banned anyone covering their face at public rallies, using the Emergency Regulations Ordinance, a British colonial law from 1922.

Opposition lawmakers challenged both the use of that emergency law and the ban on wearing masks at permitted rallies.

They argued the move breached Hong Kong's mini-constitution, the A lower court had agreed with those

bringing the challenge and expressed

concerns about the emergency law and the proportionality of the mask But yesterday, a panel of top judges

unanimously backed the government. "The ambit of the power to make subsidiary legislation under the ERO in a situation of emergency or in circumstances of public danger, although wide and flexible, was not

unconstitutional," the judges ruled. Banning face masks at both illegal and legal rallies was proportionate because it was aimed at "the prevention and deterrence of violence before a peaceful public gathering had deteriorated into violence".

Antony Dapiran, a Hong Kong lawyer who has written books about the city's protest movement, said the judges' conclusions could prove

controversial. "Most striking is the extent to which Face masks became ubiquitous to the Court of Final Appeal judgment reduce the risk of identification and privileges one narrative -- of 'violence prosecution for those taking part in and lawlessness' -- over any other, and peaceful marches, or violent clashes without the broader context in which those incidents occurred, in reaching

their conclusion," he told AFP. Hong Kong's judiciary has come under significant pressure in the politically polarised atmosphere that has blanketed the city.
