88 nominations found valid

from Syed Issa

KHULNA, Jan 15 : Nomination papers of 88 candidates were found here valid excepting one of Mr Hafizur Rahman from Khulna two.

The contenders include three former ministers, twelve former members of parliament and few prominent leaders of BNP, Awami League, Jammaat, Jatio Party and Jaker Party.

Former Minister H M A Gaffar is contesting from Khulna-five, while another former minister Amjad Hossain from Khulna-four.

two major political parties. Eyewitnesses said at about 11-30 am Monday when a clash took place between the activists of Awami League and BNP at Natunbazar in the city, at least ten persons were wounded. Among them, the condition of Saidul Gazi (24), a Sramik Dal worker, and one Abdur Rahim is stated to be critical. They are now undergoing treatment at Khulna General Hospital.

Different political parties in separate statements have called for maintaining peaceful atmosphere in the interest of free and fair elections.
