"Laws are equally applicable to all. I'm a judge and so it is not possible for me to accept a demand which is incompatible with law," he said.

The Acting President stated this in his address to the nation over radio and television tonight responding to demand raised by people, students and political parties for sending Ershad to jail and putting him on trial within a few days.

He however said that a three member inquiry commission was investigating the charges of corruption and abuse of power against Ershad.

The commission has so far received nearly 1,000 allegations against Ershad and his associates. It was impossible for his interim government to dispose of all these allegations immediately. Justice Shahabuddin said.
