Multi coloured banners and posters give the CUTs a festive



The scttlers in Chittagong Hill Tracts are generally opposed Kushum, and independent to the local government bills, which have virtually turned the Bangalees into second class citizens in Chittagopg IIIIl Tracts.

According to Ruhul Amin a member of local government in Ranghamati, the BNP candidate Nazimuddin, Zaker Party candidate Jamshed and Jamaat candidate Shahidullah at a meeting decided to vote for the Jamaat candidate in a bid to resist the election of any tribal to parliament. In this constituency the Awami League candidate Dipankar, Jatiya
