DRIK had put up a thought provoking exhibition called "Struggle for Democracy '87-'90" at the La Galerie at Banani. The work was not art for art's sake, as was stressed by Andre Raynouard, Director of the Alliance Francaise, who had inaugurated the exhibition. The selection of the pictures had not been so much on artistic merit as on the basis of the content.

The three photographers who took part in the exhibition. Dr Shahidul Alam, Altaf Hossain and Shafigul Alam, were inspired, responsible and committed. "Drik" is a word in Bangla which means an inner vision. The photographers are deeply aware of their responsibilities to their fellow citizens and are establishing their role as artists, through whose work others could see. It took courage and skill to do the work that these young men have done. Thus these collections of photos, in their own way, record history.

Dr. Shahidul Alam, 35, who has a Ph.D in Organic Chemistry and taught Chemistry founded the DRIK picture library in '88. Dr. Alam who is a self-taught photographer, won the "Norval Shield" in '83, and was awarded the "Harvey Harris Trophy" the same year.

Shafiqul Alam, 28, has been a photographer since '81, has done several photographic assignments for numerous international organisations.

Altaf Hossain. the third photographer, 27, belongs to the "Khabor" group of publications.

The exhibition traced the movement towards democracy from the day Nur Hussain died, as the first martyr of democracy, in December '90. The streets of Dhaka had become the focal point where the struggling groups had welded together. There was the dissatisfaction of the people, scattered acts of oppositions, police action, arrests and repressions. This had originally started from the military coup of '82 and had culminated in the uprising in '90, with the national struggle for honour and dignity. All this is recorded with accuracy in the exhibition of the three photographers.

There was the photo of 27th November, showing the place where Dr. Milon had been killed by a bullet. It was a few hours after this that a state of emergency was declared. This was followed by a picture showing girls from the halls rushing off for shelter, when there had been the order of the evacuation of the halls. The sense of panic and urgency was well recorded.

Since the beginning, women's groups have resisted autocracy. The "United Women's Front" protested against the establishment of Islam as state religion in '88. This was openly violating section 144. This incident was recorded with marvellous accuracy.

The painter Qamrul Hasan's cartoon of Yahya as the demon and the caricature of Ershad, made minutes before his death, were kept in mind in a rally of the students of the Arts College. The students of the Institute of Fine Arts were shown as continuing the tradition of the great artist by carrying cartoons of Ershad in public.

The opposition protests led by "Tokais" running at the police guns at the Shapla Chattar at Motifheel was also carefully recorded for all posterity.

There were scenes from the elections of 27th, February 91, in accordance with the recommendations of the three party alliance a rare example of fair and free elections in modern times — did not go unmarked.






