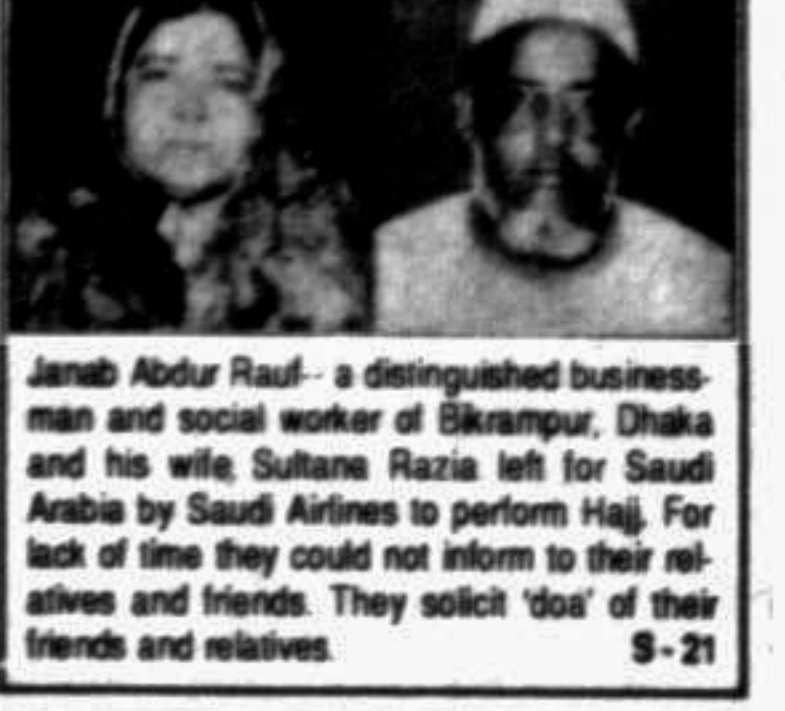
France to help reconstruct orphanages
