Rheumatic heart diseases on rise: pilot project makes headway

The incidence of rheumatic fever in Bangladesh is on the rise. According to a study, out of 424 patients of Rangpur Medical College Hospital suffering from cardiovascular diseases, 34 per cent was of rheumatic origin, said Dr Ainun Afroza of the Institute of Post-Graduate Medicine and Research at a recent international symposium held in New Delhi.
