DUJ formulating 'action plan' Govt not cooperating in solving crisis

Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) in a meeting of the Executive Committee with DUJ President Zahurul Haq in the chair adopted some proposals on the recent situation in the newspaper industries.

The meeting regretted that the government was not cooperating in solving the stalemate situation in the Dainik Desh existing since last three months. The journalists were frustrated as the government became silent after taking initiatives.

The meeting said the authority of the Desh who collaborated with the Ershad regime did not hesitate to assault the journalist leaders. But, the case filed in this connection has not yet been investigated.

Ctg-Karachi distance can be reduced by 500 miles

Dredging a deep water channel in the shallow 22-mile wide Palk straits, between India and Sri Lanka, would reduce the distance between Chittagong and Karachi by about 500 miles, reports UNB.

The weekly further stated "the waters in the region of Palk straits are very shallow, having a depth of about 12 feet. Country crafts and mechanised launches can navigate in the area, but it is too shallow even for small freighters and coasters."

New steamer on Dhaka-Barisal route

Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Corporation (BIWTC) has placed another special steamer on the Dhaka-Barisal line which will leave Sadarghat on June 20 at 3-00 pm reports BSS.

New body of Shangkritik Jote

Sammilita Shangkritik Jote (Combined Cultural Alliances) in its council meeting on Friday adopted the organisation's constitution and elected a 21-member executive committee with Fayed Ahmed as President and Golam Kuddus as Secretary.

The council meeting was inaugurated by eminent singer Sheikh Lutfor Rahman while it was presided over by Barrister Syed Ishtiaq Ahmed. The meeting was also addressed by Prof Kabir Chowdhury, Prof Sirajul Islam Chowdhury and Kamal Lohani.

Shantibahini shot 22 dead from January to April

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia informed the Jatiya Sangsad Monday that Shantibahini men shot dead 12 tribal people and 10 non-tribals from January to April 30 this year, reports BSS.
