# Timber consumption to rise by 75m cubic feet

Bangladesh Timber Traders and Saw Mill Owners' Samity has threatened to launch a movement if the government fails to fulfil their five-point demand immediately, reports UNB.

Afzal Hossain, General Secretary of the Samity said this at a press conference in a local hotel in Dhaka on Monday.

Chaired by Habibur Rahman, President of the Samity, the press conference was also attended, among others, by Assistant Vice-Presidents Helaluddin and Abul Kasem.

Their demands include exemption of tax on import and selling of timbers, stoppage of timber smuggling and creation of opportunity for afforestation in the private sector.

The government have imposed 40 per cent tax on import of timber, which Afzal said would affect construction works in the country adversely.

Referring to imposition of Value Added Tax (VAT), Afzal said this would seriously affect about 10 million people involved directly or indirectly with timber trade.

He feared that the timber consumption in the construction sector would increase by 75 million cubic feet by the year 2000 hastening environmental degradation.

Afzal demanded inclusion of timber traders in government's afforestation programmes in coastal areas and fallow lands.

The government lost revenue worth about Tk 300 crore during the last two years due to unauthorised felling of trees.

# Indian cargo ships ply in Bangladesh

Indian cargo ships ply in the Bangladesh territory under the protocol on inland water transit and trade, signed between Bangladesh and India, Shipping Minister MK Anwar told the Jatiya Sangsad Monday, reports BSS.

Replying a question from Mostafa Rashid Shuja (AL-Khulna), Shipping Minister said Indian ships can not anchor in the Bangladesh ports excepting Sheikh-Bari, Khulna, Barisal, Chandpur, Srajanj, Bahadurabad, Chilmari, Narayanganj, Bhairab Bazar, Ajmiriganj, Markuli, Sherpur, Fenchuganj and Zakiganj. Indian ships can anchor in these river ports for unloading goods, re-fuelling and by buying essentials, he said.

The Minister said the Indian government mainly bears the expenses of maintenance of navigability of the routes they use.

He said approved ships ply on eight protocol routes in both the countries.

# Rule to regulate ad on breast milk substitute soon

A Draft Rule Under Section 11 of the "Breast Milk Substitute (Regulation and Marketing) Amendment Act, 1990", is being prepared to enforce the law to regulate advertisement of breast milk substitutes.

Health and Family Welfare Minister Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yusuf told the Jatiya Sangsad Monday that the act prohibits making, exhibition, distribution, circulation and open display of advertisements of breast milk substitute which might create impression that the substitute was equal to breast milk.

Replying to a question from Col (Retd) Sawkat Ali (AL-Sariatpur), the Minister said the act would be enforced after the gazette notification of the rule.

He also informed the House that an "advisory committee" was formed to extend cooperation to the government in this regard.

# 230 EDM vehicles for rural recovery

The Enfants du Monde, a Geneva-based non-governmental organisation, on Monday distributed 184 bi-cycles and 46 motor cycles among field level workers and Upazila Social Services Officers respectively at a simple ceremony at the EDM headquarters in Dhaka.

The Secretary of the Ministry of Social Welfare Fazlullah was present when the EDM Country Coordinator Peter Amacher and Director, (Programme), DSS distributed the vehicles for smooth functioning of the programme aimed at poverty alleviation in rural areas.

The Secretary also attended the 43rd joint coordination meeting of the Upazila Social Services Officers, Department of Social Services (DSS), Government of Bangladesh and the Field Coordinator, Enfants du Monde (EDM), an International Voluntary Organization, working for Swiss Government in Bangladesh.

The Rural Family and Child Welfare project has been implemented jointly by EDM and DSS to strengthen the Rural Social Services Programme of DSS. EDM provides financial and technical assistance.

The Secretary discussed in details with the Field Officers and termed this collaborative effort as a unique system of co-operation for poverty alleviation in Bangladesh through GOB structure. He mentioned that this is the exceptional programme package to embrace the needs of below poverty level families for their improvements. He highlighted the importance of this programme, in comparison to some other Rural Development Programmes. He categorically said, the programme needs publicity for its recognition because of its practical characteristics and inherent quality.

Peter Amacher described performances of the joint project as quite encouraging and the rate of achievement ranges from 90-100% since the inception of the project. He added it is a very good model of joint collaboration and poverty alleviation.

# No plan for new medical college

The government has no immediate plan to set up any new medical college in the country, Health and Family Welfare Minister Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yusuf told the Jatiya Sangsad Monday, reports BSS.

In reply to a question from Tabibur Rahman Sardar (AL-Maksud Ibne Aziz (JP-Sylhet), the minister said at present there were eight public and three private medical colleges in the country.

Answering another question from Abdul Matin Khasru (AL-Cornilla), Chowdhury Yusuf said the government had no immediate plan to re-start the Cornilla Medical College.

Chowdhury said that the projects setting up of a hospital with kidney transplantation facilities was being considered in the Fourth Five-Year Plan.

He said implementation of the project would be with the availability of fund.

Replying a question from Tabibur Rahman Sardar (AL-Jessore), the minister said talks for assistance in this regard were being held with the Japanese government.

In reply to a supplementary, he said, discussion with the Geneva-based World Health Organisation (WHO) were also being held. He said commitments for assistance from the WHO had also been received.

Answering a question from Nurul Islam Moni (Ind-Barguna), Chowdhury Yusuf said that Taka 1,410 crore 20 lakh 60 thousand was spent in the family welfare sector from 1972 to 1990.

He said the birth rate per thousand was 47.4 in 1974 which had come down to 33 in 1989. He said birth rate was 6.3 per cent in 1974 and it has come down to 4.5 per cent in 1989.

State Minister for Education Principal Mohammad Yunus Khan chaired the meeting.

# Royal Malaysian Navy ships end goodwill visit

CHITTAGONG, July 8: The Royal Malaysian Navy ships which arrived at Chittagong on July 5, left Bangladesh this evening ending their three-day goodwill visit, an ISPR release said.

During their stay in Bangladesh the commanding officers of the ships made courtesy call on the Local Area Commander of the Bangladesh Army, the Commodore Commanding Chittagong, the Commodore Commanding BN Flotilla, Air Officer Commanding of the local air base and Mayor of the Chittagong City Corporation.

Other activities of the ships included visit to the Sailors' Training Complex at Kaptal, friendly basketball and volleyball matches with the BN Flotilla team and receptions in honour of the visiting ships by Bangladesh Navy.

The Malaysian Navy ships also hosted similar reception attended by the Malaysian High Commissioner in Bangladesh Ms Tunku Nazihah Binte Mohamad Rus and high civil and military officials.

The ships were kept open to the members of public and drew a large number of people.

# Cultural agreements with 38 countries

Bangladesh has cultural exchange agreements with 38 countries, Education and Cultural Affairs Minister Prof AQM Badruddoza Chowdhury told the Jatiya Sangsad Monday, reports BSS.

In reply to a question from Shah Mohammad Rafiqul Bari Chowdhury (Sherpur-1) the Minister said, the countries with which Bangladesh has cultural agreements are: India, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Bhutan, the Maldives, Pakistan, Afghanistan, Egypt, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Kuwait, Turkey, UAE, Malaysia, China, North Korea, South Korea, Japan, the Philippines, Thailand, Libya, Algeria, Morocco, Zambia, Senegal, Somalia, Zimbabwe, Bulgaria, Czechoslovakia, now defunct GDR, Hungary, Mongolia, Romania, the Soviet Union, Yugoslavia, France and Brazil.

He said 24 cultural teams under the agreements had been able to project the culture of Bangladesh abroad.

Answering a question from Tabibur Rahman Sardar (AL-Jessore-1), State Minister for Information Mohammad Nurul Huda informed the House that Bangladesh had not signed any 'film agreement' with India.

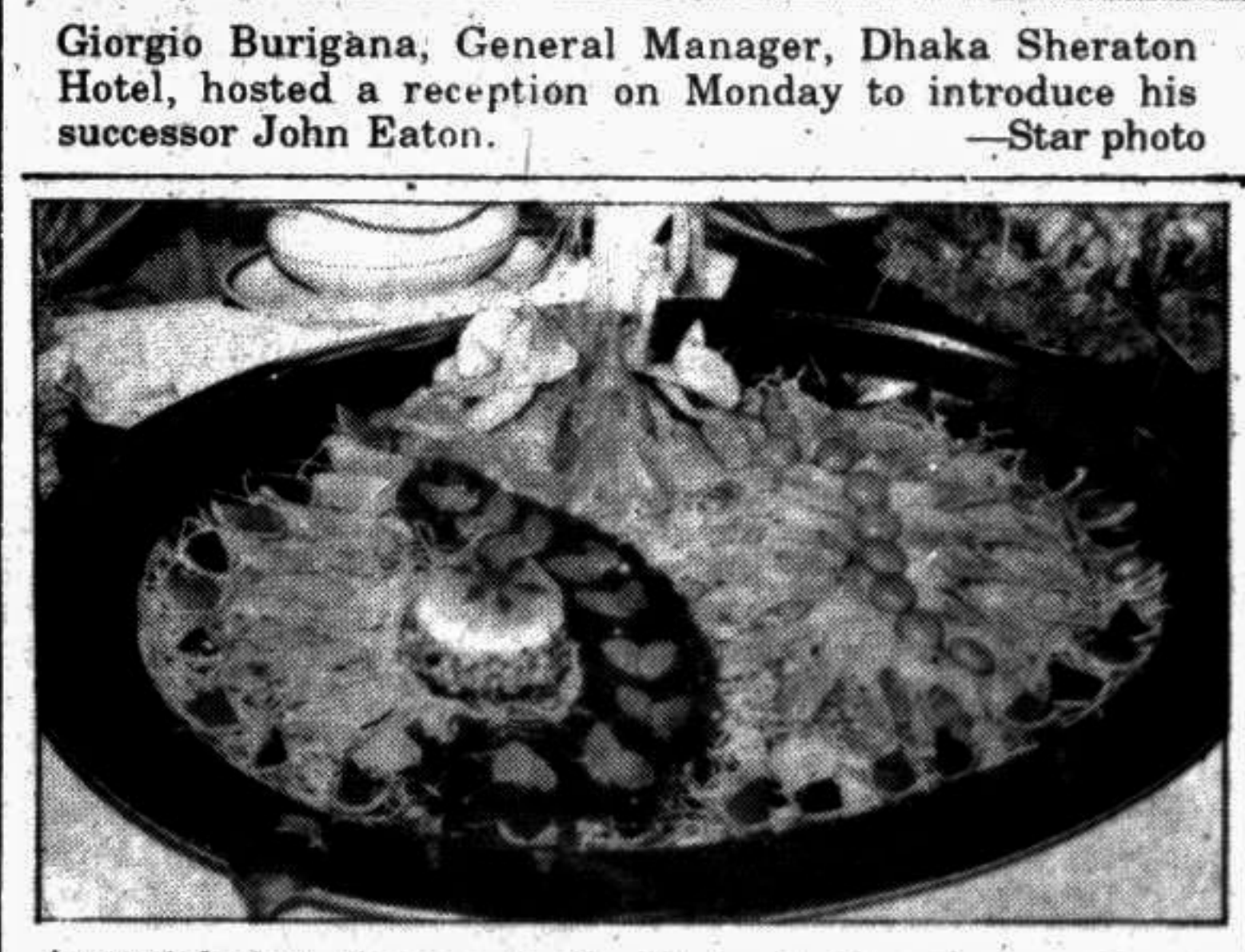
Police recovered a revolver and five rounds of bullets from Sukrabad Sunday night. One Saiful Islam alias Himel was arrested in this connection.
