

1,600 tribal rebels surrender so far

CHITTAGONG, July 11: So far about 1600 tribal rebels known as "Shanti Bahini" surrendered to military forces.

An official source reported today that those tribal insurgents surrendered themselves separately to army outposts located at insurgency town in Chittagong hill districts.

Among them 52 persons surrendered over the past six months period. Most of them surrendered with arms and returned to normal life. The

source added, a bulk of tribal rebels numbering 235 belonging to "Pariti" faction surren dered with arms in 1985 taking advantage of general amnesty declared by the three government. But another group known as "Larma" faction continued their fight and a large number of them laid down their arms at various times. About 5000 insurgents have been waiting since 18-year insurgency in Chittagong hill tracts for provincial autonomy.


