Since the energization of the Comilla-1 PBS in January 1981, 33 per cent of the villages in the six upazilas-Daudkandi, Chandina, Devidwar, Muradnagar, Borua and Homna were electrified. Under this PBS a total of 37,441 power connections including 28,450 domestic, 6187 commercial and 1075 irrigation have been given. The system loss in the PBS is 13.5 per cent, the officials of the samity said.

Brig Mowla said about 200 upazilas in the country have so far been brought under rural electrification programme through 39 PBS. He said till now 22,546 irrigation pumps have been electrified. In ten years of rural electri-
