"Although the present treaty provides only about 30 per cent curtailment of the total stockpiles of US-Soviet long range nuclear arsenals. the peace-loving people of the world will continue their demand for complete elimination of all nuclear and other mass-annihilating weapons of war," Aksad said.

He also expressed his satisfaction over the joint declaration of Bush and Gorbachev for holding the proposed Middle-East peace conference in October this year for a comprehensive settlement of the Middle-East problems.
