IDA soft-loan slows down

Fresh soft-loan sanctions by International Development (IDA) to Association Bangladesh have slowed down. to Bangladesh stood lower in The IDA approved loans,

amounting to 459.7 million US Dollar for a total of six projects or programmes, in Bangladesh in fiscal year 1991. The amount was 540.1 million US Dollar in 1990.

The fiscal year of IDA, the soft loan-giving affiliate body of the World Bank, is from July to June. Bangladesh's entire amount of multilateral external aid from the World Bank has been through IDA window.

The just-released Annual Report 1991 of the World Bank showed that the IDA's global lending operations, in terms of fresh commitments, stood a 6293.3 million Dollar in fiscal 1991 and the amount was 771.3 million Dollar above fiscal 1990's record amount of 5.5 billion Dollar.

The commitments by IDA rose on a global scale during the year under report despite

assistance on June 30, 1990. in terms of cumulative lending operations upto June 30, 1991, Bangladesh was the second largest recipient of IDA support, the first being India with the amount totalling 17983.1 million Dollar.

The IDA credits, approved for Bangladesh in fiscal 1991. included: (1) the 180-million Dollar Fourth Population and Health Project, (2) the 75 million Dollar Shallow Tubewell and Low Lift Pump Irrigation Project, (3) the 67.2 million Dollar Liquefied Petroleum Gas Transport and Distribution Project, (4) the 54 Million Dollar National Minor Irrigation Development Project, (5) the 45 million Dollar Third Inland Water Transport Project, (6) the 35 million Dollar Agricultural Support Services Project and (7) the 3.5 million Dollar Supplementary Fund for Financial Sector Adjustment Credit.
