NAP demands repeal of black laws

National Awami Party (NAP) on Sunday staged a sit-in in front of National Press Club demanding repeal of black laws.

Party President Noor Mohammad Kazi accused the ruling party of betraying with the people as it promised to repeal all black laws including Special Powers Act during February election.

He also criticized both BNP and Awami League for seeking blessings from a controversial Pakistani National Golan Azam.

The NAP President said that both the parties marred the sanctity of the War of Independence.

He was also critical of 25-year Indo-Bangladesh Friendship Treaty which gave facilities to India to dominate us and demanded its cancellation.

Kazi expressed concern over the post-flood diarrhoeal situation in North Bengal and urged the government to take immediate measures.

Chief Adviser of the party Mujibur Rahman Advocate, General Secretary Sekandar Ali and Vice-President Shah Alam Bhuyan also addressed the rally.
