Justice Siddique Ahmed Chowdhury said only religion can bring world peace and universal brotherhood.

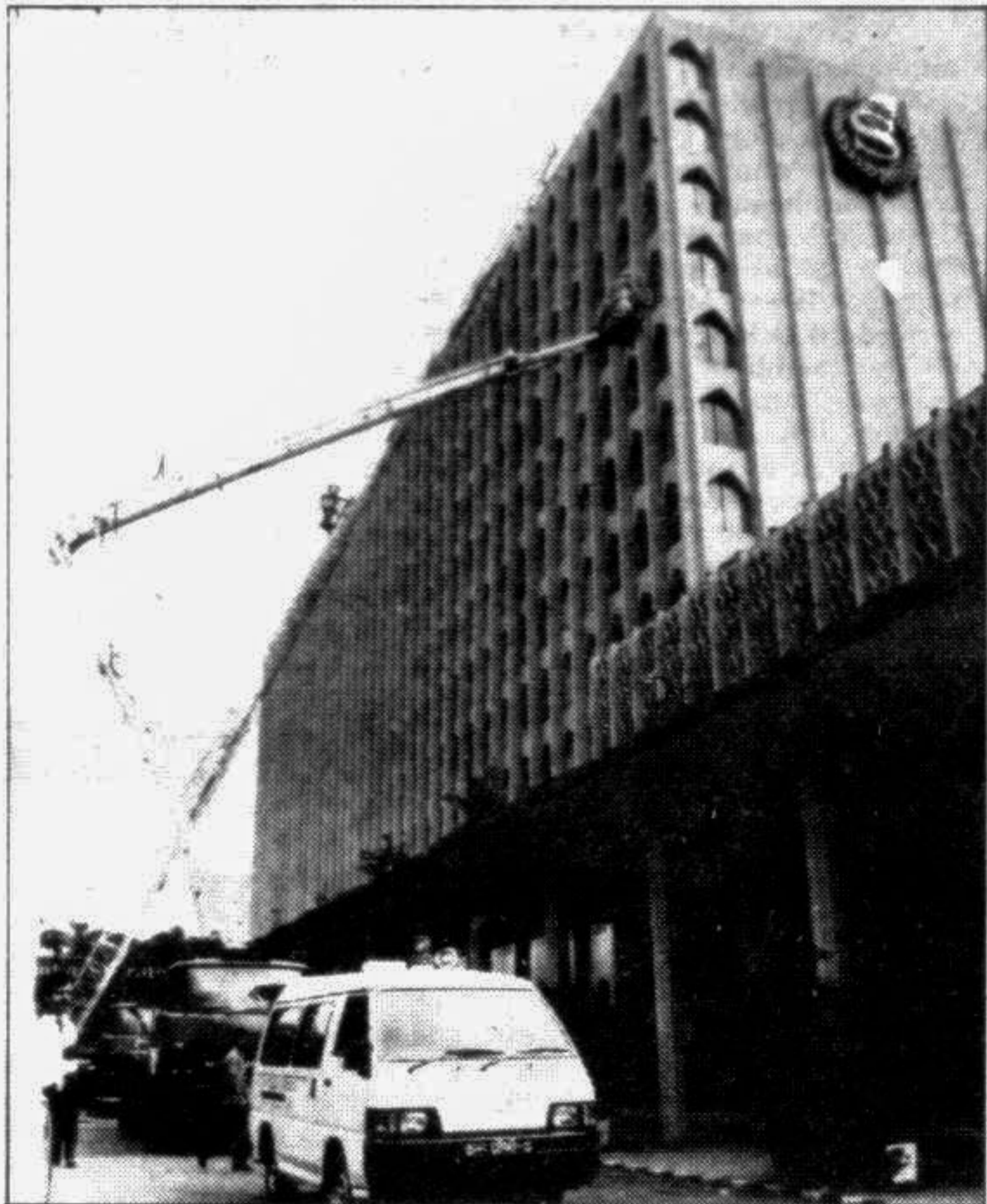
Justice Debesh Chandra Bhattacharjee said there is no basic difference in the principles of all religions and the message of 'love of God and love of mankind' should be communicated to all.
