Four people, including three girls, died in four separate incidents, hospital sources said Monday, reports

Rickshaw-puller Edris Miah (40) died on the spot when a mini-bus dashed his rickshaw in front of Kakrail mosque in the morning.

His body was brought to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) for autopsy. The driver fled away along

with the bus (Dhaka-Cha-599). Parvin Aktar (15) of village Satarkul in Gulshan area al

legedly committed suicide by taking poison.

Hasina (16), a maid servant of 14/26 Avaya Das lane, who fell down from the roof of a three-storey building, succumbed to her injuries at DMCH Sunday night. Relatives took away her

body after post-mortem. Roksana (18), a house wife of Masimpur village in Tongi, was stabbed to death allegedly by her husband Sentu on Sunday over family feud. She

died at DMCH early today. Sentu was reported absconding.
