## Isolation from nature intensifies environmental problems

Environment experts in an International Workshop began in Dhaka Monday suggesting that Bangladesh should apply the procedures of modern aquatic ecology in solving the environmental problems, reports UNB.

They said Bangladesh was confronted with an environmental crisis with the progress of science and technology like many other countries in the region.

The problem intensified particularly in Bangladesh due to increasing impact of population, industrialisation, urbanisation and isolation from the nature, they observed.

The workshop jointly organised by Science and Technology Division, Ministry of Education, Department of Botany and Commission of the European Communities, is aimed at finding ways and means to protect and improve freshwater aquatic ecosystem of Bangladesh.


