BCL alleges repression on its workers

The Awami League-backed Chhatra League on Thursday held a rally in front of National Press Club protesting alleged repression by the government on BCL (S-A) workers throughout the country.

Referring to a news item published in a daily Thursday that the Home Ministry had prepared a list of 'terrorists' from among Dhaka University students, the BCL leaders alleged that the list was not impartial and said that the names of 'terrorists' like Sanaul Huq Niru, Ilias Alt, Ratan, Abdul Malek Shapu were not included in the list.

The BCL cancelled its programme of handing over a memorandum to the Home Ministry saying that "the government's attitude is undemocratic."

"We won't receive fair judgement from this government," a BCL leader said.
