Speaking as the chief guest at a function in connection with giving Maulana Akram Khan Memorial Gold Medal Award-1991, the President said that the role of journalism and its freedom in building society and cementing the foundation of democracy was indispensable and inseparable.

Paying tributes to the memory of Maulana Akram Khan, the President said he (Akram) was a pioneer in the field of journalism in the country. He recalled the role of daily Azad and monthly Mohammadi in inspiring the deprived people of the country against exploitation, injustice, ignorance and superstition. Presided over by the President of Journalist Maulana Mohammad Akram Khan Smriti Sangsad, Alhaj ANM Yusuf, the function was also addressed by Dewan Mohammad Azraf, journalist AKA Mohtuddin, Major General Dr AR Khan and Mr Maniruzzaman Vice President and Secretary of the Sangsad respectively.

Paying homage to the shaheed journalists, the President

Incorrect reports misguide people: Speaker Newsmen urged to be familiarized with parliamentary norms

Speaker of the Jatiya Sangsad Shakh Razaque Ali on Saturday called upon the journalists to equip themselves properly with the knowledge of parliamentary norms including the Rules of Procedure and constitution for smooth and clear reporting, reports BSS.

He referred to incorrect reports about parliament sessions published by the newspapers recently and said it happened due to lack of proper knowledge about the subject. Incorrect report has mislead the people, on parliamentary reporting, he said.

The Speaker was inaugurating a five-day workshop on legislative reporting at Hotel Purbani here. It was jointly organized by Asia Foundation, Asian Mass Communication Research and Information Centre (AMIC) and Department of Mass Communication and Journalism of Dhaka University.

Presided over by the department's chairman Dr. Golam Rahman, the inaugural session was also addressed by Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof. Moniruzzaman Mia, AMIC representative Dr. Tawhidul Anwar, former

chairman of the department Dr. Q. I. M. Nuruddin and Dr. Victor T. Valbuena of AMIC, Singapore.

Twenty-two journalists from six SAARC countries including 10 from Bangladesh except Bhutan are taking part in the workshop which will be conducted by resources persons from home and Australia, Pakistan and Sri Lanka. Yesterday's session began with a lecture by distinguished lawyer Dr. Kamal Hossain on an overview of representative legislative bodies in democracy.

The Speaker called for improvement in legislative reporting in the SAARC countries marking it more appreciable in the greater interest of the people of the region.

Referring to the legal system in the SAARC countries, the Speaker said it was inherited from the foreign masters and called for its review as old ideas were still working on the people of the region. "Besides, resources constraints and illiteracy are also common problem in the region," he said.

Shaikh Razaque Ali said Bangladesh was now standing on the threshold of an exciting new era with its switching

over to parliamentary democracy. He said journalists should now play more responsible role in reporting the parliamentary sessions as the government was now being made accountable to parliament.

"We had parliamentary system soon after the independence of Bangladesh but it could not function," he said urging the journalists to carry forward the activities of parliament to the people by their smooth and clear reporting.

Prof. Moniruzzaman Mia called upon journalists to play their due role in contributing towards restoring peace on the campuses now passing through a difficult time due to violence.

"If violence continues, our development efforts will suffer. He urged the journalists to follow ethics and sense of objectivity while writing about campus violence.

The DU Vice-Chancellor also said the change in the form of government was made possible because the people liked it. He called upon all to share the responsibility of upholding the democratic trend by not leaving it to the government or parliament alone.

Friends and admirers have been requested to attend the mlad.



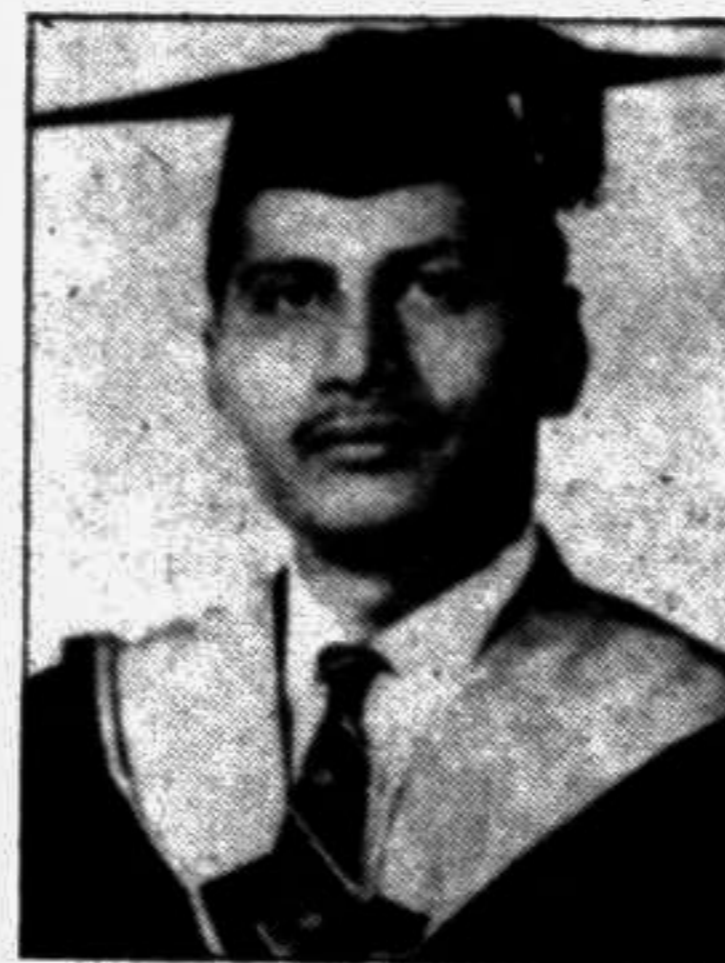
Dr Fazole Rabbi's anniversary of death today

The 20th death anniversary of Dr Md Fazole Rabbi will be observed today (Sunday).

Dr Rabbi, a leading physician of his time, was a freedom fighter and fell in wrath of the Pakistani occupation army. He was lifted from his residence at Siddheswari in the city in the afternoon of December 15, 1971 by Pak army and was brutally killed at Rayerbazar. His body was recovered and buried on December 18.

Quran khwani and mlad mahfil will be held today after Johr prayers at Ganabhanan mosque for the peace of his departed soul. Wreaths will be placed at his grave at New Azimpur graveyard at 8-30 am and Fatcha will be offer thereafter. Food will be distributed among the destitutes at the graveyard at noon.

The 20th anniversary of death of Shaheed Dr Abul Kalam Azad will be observed tomorrow, says a press release.

Dr Azad was brutally killed by Al-Badar Bahini at the fag end of the Liberation War. His body was recovered from the mass grave at Rayer Bazar on December 16, 1971.

On the occasion of his death anniversary a Milad Mahfil and Quran Khwani will be held at the residence of the mother of Shaheed Dr Azad at House No. 35/B, Road No.7, Block-G, Banani, Dhaka after Asr prayers tomorrow.
