Cracks have developed in the building constructed at a cost of Taka 17 lakh last year. During monsoon season water leakage creates various problems, which hampers normal functioning of the office.


Different parts of the build-ing were severely damaged due to the use of low quality con struction materials and lack of proper maintenance.

Moreover, the telephone booth of the office is not sound proof, essential for any modern telephone booth.

Clients and local journalists are facing problem as there is no sitting arrangement. Poor electrification of the building also giving troubles to the office staffs and the subscribers

Besides, employees of the office are not available during emergency hours, as there is nor residential arrangement for the staffs.


