Telegraph office in Rangamati still inoperative

CHITTAGONG, Dec 18: The local telegraph office in Rangamati still remains inoperative due to manifold problems, reports UNIL.

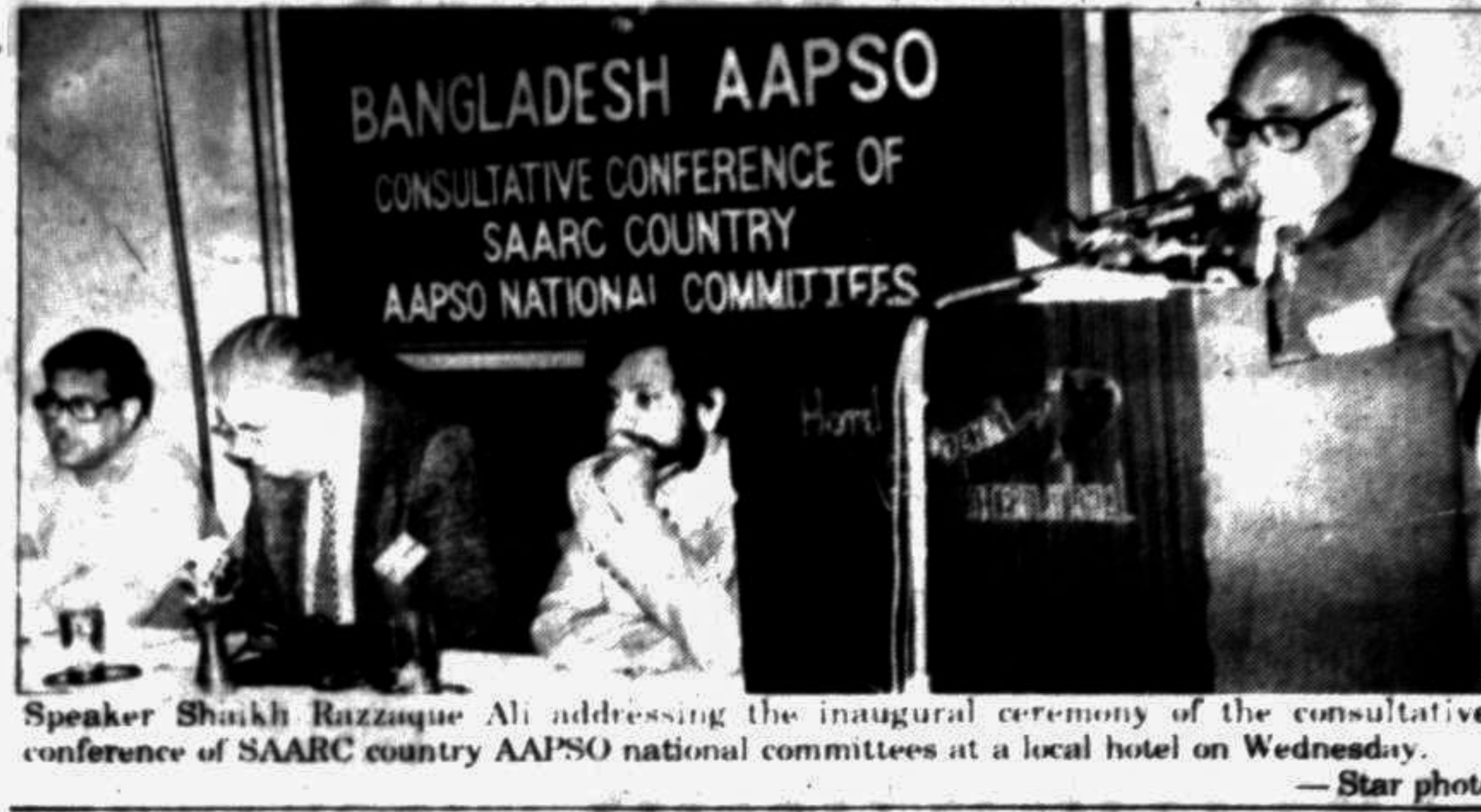
Cracks have developed in the building constructed at a cost of Taka 17 lakh last year. During monsoon season water leakage creates various problems, which hampers normal functioning of the office.

Different parts of the building were severely damaged due to the use of low quality construction materials and lack of proper maintenance.

Moreover, the telephone booth of the office is not sound proof, essential for any modern telephone booth.

Clients and local journalists are facing problem as there is no sitting arrangement. Poor electrification of the building also giving troubles to the office staffs and the subscribers as well.

Besides, employees of the office are not available during emergency hours, as there is no residential arrangement for the staffs.

HERE and THERE

Sociology Department

A meeting held at Sociology Department of Dhaka University on Wednesday paid tributes to Abu Toha Md Jafarullah (Liton), a student of the department, who was killed during a campus violence on October 27 this year.

Presided over by department's chairman Syed Ahmed Khan, the meeting was addressed by Dr. Rangalal Sen, Dr. Helaluddin Khan Arefin, Dr. Zahidul Islam and others. The speakers at the meeting urged all concerned to resist the violence on the campus.

Atomic Energy Commission

Lt Col (Retd) Heshamuddin Ahmed, Secretary, Science and Technology Division of Education Ministry distributed certificates among the participants of the international consultative group on food irradiation held at the auditorium of the Atomic Energy Research Establishment (AERE) on Wednesday at Savar.

Dr M A Mannan, Chairman, Bangladesh Atomic Energy Commission presided over the function. IAEA staff member Dr Mdnuddin Ahmed, workshop organising secretary Dr M Matur Rahman and workshop national counterpart M A Matin also addressed the function.

National Workers Federation

The National Workers Federation in a statement on Wednesday criticised the Prime Minister for not mentioning anything on the minimum wages for the workers in her address to the nation on the eve of the Victory Day.

The statement issued by Alamgir Majumder and Anisul Haq, President and General Secretary of the Federation respectively, observed the Prime Minister's comment in the address that 'wage commission would be formed soon' would only benefit the workers of the nationalised industries and would not fulfil the demands of the private sector industries.

Chemical Industries Sramik Fed

Bangladesh Chemical Industries Sramik Federation on Wednesday called upon all concerned to make a success the proposed 72-hour strike from December 22.

The Sramik Karmachari Oikya Parishad (SKOP) called the strike to press home its five-point charter of demand. The federation leaders Tofael Ahmed and Belayet Hossain Majumder in a statement regretted that the present democratic government did not take any effective steps regarding the demands.

They also demanded of the government to accept the demands of the jute and cotton workers.

Women for Women

A seminar on women in the urban informal sector, organised by the 'Women for Women', a research and study group, was held recently at the organisation's premises.

Prof Khaleda Salahuddin and Ishrat Shamim, both members of the 'Women for Women' presented their recently completed study on 'women in the urban informal sector'.

The study revealed that large segment of the working women of the informal sector in the Dhaka city consists of migrants from the rural areas of the country. They are mostly 'push' migrants from the poor, landless households having no rural options, the study said.

Democratic Revolutionary Front

Leaders of the Democratic Revolutionary Front in a statement on Wednesday condemned the remark by the Jamaat-e-Islami Secretary General Matur Rahman Nizami on killing of intellectuals during the Liberation War in 1971.

Badruddin Omar, M Nurunabi, Lutfar Rahman, Abrir Hassan and Fatul Halkim in the statement termed Nizami's comment that the Awami League had killed the intellectuals

Muktijoddha Sangsad

Bangladesh Muktijoddha Sangsad (Freedom Fighters Council) on Wednesday condemned the armed attack on the Sylhet unit of the Sangsad and ransacking of the unit's office by some unknown persons recently.

The Sangsad Chairman Principal Abdul Ahad and its Secretary General Abdul Aziz, Birprotik, in a statement demanded investigation into the incident and punishment to the persons responsible for the incident. Otherwise, the freedom fighters across the country would launch protest programme against the attack, they warned.

Jatiya Sramik Jote

Jatiya Sramik Jote on Wednesday postponed its public gathering scheduled to be held in front of the Allawala Building at Motijheel Commercial Area in the city today (Thursday) at 4 pm.

A press release of the Jote said that instead of the public rally the jote will now hold a meeting of its national committee on December 27 at 11 am at its central office. The press release, however, did not mention any reason for the postponement of the rally.

BCSIR

A discussion on shahed intellectuals was held at the auditorium of Bangladesh Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (BCSIR) on Sunday morning.

Organised by BCSIR the discussion meeting was attended by Dr M. Waliuzzaman, chairman BCSIR as chief guest while Dr M A Rahman presided. Dr Sydul Haq, G K Joardar, Kazi Formuzul Haq, Siddiqur Rahman and Azizur Rahman addressed the meeting.

The meeting was followed by a special prayer offered for the salvation of the departed souls of the shahed intellectuals.

ABCS newsletter

The first issue of the newsletter of Association of British Council Scholars (ABCS) has been launched on December 16. The newsletter will be published quarterly.

The ABCS was formed last year with the aim to perpetuate links between Britain and Bangladesh which might be mutually beneficial to the British Council and the scholars.

JSD (Rab)

Jatiya Samajtantrik Dal (JSD-Rab) held a discussion at Fakirerpool in the city on Wednesday in connection with celebration of the Victory Day.

The city unit Vice-President of the party Kazi Abdus Sattar chaired the meeting which was also addressed, among others, by the party's central leaders Prof Humayun Kabir Iluru and Nurul Akhter and Jatiya Sramik Jote leader Wali Ahmed Patwari.

The speakers called upon the people to complete the 'unfinished' Liberation war with a view to founding a sovereign Bangladesh for the Bangladesh and demanded immediate release of party leader ASM Abdur Rab who first hoisted the national flag.

Jamaat-e-Islami

Acting Amec of the Jamaat-e-Islami Abbas Ali Khan on Wednesday called upon the people of Bakerganj-5 constituency to vote for the Jamaat candidate Abul Hasanat Mohammad Nurullah to strengthen the Islamic movement in the country.

According to a press release, Khan was addressing a projection meeting organised in favour of the Jamaat candidate at Bales Park of Barisal.

The meeting was also addressed by the party Secretary General and its Parliamentary Party leader Matur Rahman Nizami, Assistant Secretary General Ali Ahsan Muhammad Mujahid, central leaders including Sheikh Ansar Ali, Sardar Abdus Salam and Prof Mahmud Hossain Al Mannan.

7 pirates held

KHULNA, Dec 18: A patrol squad of the Bangladesh Navy apprehended seven pirates with two locally manufactured firearms from Mongla Nalah last night, reports BSS.

The pirates were nabbed rehandened while they were engaged in distribution of the booty onboard a mechanised fishing boat.

Other items recovered from them included four rounds of gun ammunition, seven daos, two axes, one knife, about 3000 feet fishing net and 25 maunds of mixed fish.

The arrested persons were later handed over to police along with goods worth about Taka 5 lakh 60 thousands.

A case has also been lodged in this connection.

Obituary

A former member of parliament Mr. Abdur Rashid died of old-age complications at Magura on December 11, according to a late message received in Dhaka on Wednesday, reports BSS.

He was 74.

He left behind his wife, three sons, five daughters and a host of friends and admirers to mourn his death.

A veteran social worker and freedom fighter, Mr. Rashid organised the liberation war in Magura. He was elected MP with Awami League ticket in 1973. Late Mr. Rashid founded Alokika Omorash College, Magura, and was associated with a number of educational institutions.

Afzalur Rahman

Afzalur Rahman, Deputy Secretary of Election Commission died of cardiac problem at Suhrawardy hospital on Wednesday. He was 57.

His namaz-e-janaza will be held today (Thursday) at Baitul Mukarram Mosque after Zohr prayer and he will be buried at Baniar graveyard the same day.

He left behind his wife, one daughter, two sons, a host of relatives and many admirers to mourn his death.

Mosharrat Hossain

Syed Mosharrat Hossain, a retired section officer, died Wednesday afternoon at his residence at 69, RK Mission Road in the city. He was 92.

He was suffering from old age ailments.

The namaz-e-janaza of Syed Mosharrat Hossain will be held today (Thursday) after Zohr prayers at the Tikatuli Mosque.

Golam Hafiz

Mr Kang Dal Son, ambassador of Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK) to Bangladesh called on Law and Justice Minister Mirza Golam Hafiz at his office on Wednesday, reports BSS.

They discussed various matters related to mutual interests of their respective countries.

Govt to protect animals for ecological balance

Education Minister Jamilur Ruddy Sircar Wednesday said, the government would reinforce the concerned law to protect the wild animals and birds for maintaining ecological balance, reports BSS.

He called upon the people and the bird specialists to preserve the rare species of birds and animals for making the environment peaceful and quiet.

The minister was speaking at a function held during his visit to the migratory birds at the Dhaka Zoo. The migratory birds have started coming to the zoo since early November and have already attracted a large number of visitors every day.

The function was jointly organised by the Zoology Department of Dhaka University, Bangladesh Birds Preservation Society, Bangladesh Wild Zoology Association and Dhaka Zoo.

Bird specialist Prof. Kazi Zaker Hossain and Dr. Shahadat Ali also spoke on the occasion.
