MPs urged to amend laws to make BDRCS more dynamic

President Abdur Rahman Biswas Sunday called for giving the Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) a new outlook to render service to the suffering humanity in accordance with the principles of humanitarian services of the present democratic government, reports BSS.

Inaugurating the two-day 19th annual conference of the BDRCS the President urged all concerned to evaluate the role of the society in a new perspective, so that it could render greater service to the people of the country.

President Biswas said Red Crescent Society was a humanitarian organisation and its service to the suffering humanity has been recognised by all. The President urged all concerned to inject new vigor and dynamism to the organisation so that its activities are well-recognised both at home and abroad.

President Abdur Rahman Biswas who is also the President of the Society, hoped that the MPs of the present Parliament would look into the problems of the BDRCS and amend the existing laws to make the organisation more dynamic and workable.

The conference was addressed, among others by the Chairman of the society Syed Shahidul Huq Jamal, MP, Justice T A Khan, Major (ret'd) Ali Hasan Quareshi, Secretary General and Alhaj Siddiqur Rahman, Vice Chairman of the society.

MPs, diplomats, senior officials and over one hundred Red Crescent field volunteers attended the conference.

President Biswas appreciated the present democratic election system for the society saying that it would make the organisation more representative and dynamic.

Speaking on the occasion the chairman of the Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) Syed Shahidul Huq Jamal stated that the society had firm faith and respect in the principles and objectives of the movement. "We must hold high the principles of services, universality, neutrality and all other objectives that the movement stands for,"

He said the government was well aware of the problems of the country and would solve them as per its commitment to the national for overall socio-economic development.

The minister was addressing as the chief guest a reception given by Uttarbanga Unnayan Parishad to the Minister, State Ministers and Whips hailing from North Bengal at the National Press Club.

Besides, he said, the government had also allocated Taka 350 crore for the development of Barind Project for growing more food for attaining a self-reliant economy.

The Education Minister said Shahid President Ziaur Rahman had taken initiative to establish medical colleges in Dinajpur, Bogra and Pabna.

The Ershad regime did not implement that programme, he said adding that the present government would set up these Medical Colleges as desired by Shahid President Ziaur Rahman.

The Education Minister said that he had already informed the Prime Minister, Begum Khaleda Zia about the demand of the northern region for establishing a university in Rangpur.
