## Ctg businesses asked to register with VAT Collectorate by tomorrow

CHITTAGONG, Dec 29: The revenue authorities, in the face of rampant evasion of VAT (Value Added Tax) in the Chittagong zone, have asked traders to register with VAT Collectorate by December 31, reports UNB.

Official sources warned that failure to register with the collectorate would make the business houses liable for legal action.

Authorities have also asked evadors to pay their accumulated dues.

According to Chittagong Collectorate, about 90 per cent of the service sector in the zone including restaurants. engineering workshops. sweetmeat shops, travel agents and construction firms were yet to register with the collectorate.

Since the new tax system came into effect in July, most

business firms, particularly in the service sector, have been agitating in an organised manner against the system.

They have formed a "VAT Resistance Action Council which is planning a series of actions in view of growing pressure from the authorities.

On December 24, restaurants and sweetmeat shops in the port city kept their shutters down for 24 hours demanding exemption of VAT.

A senior official of the Chittagong VAT Collectorate admitted widespread evasion of VAT despite the fact that revenue collection from the system has been satisfactory.

To evade VAT, many large industrial units here have reportedly been giving sub-contract to small workshops which are exempted from the system.

Jamaluddin, who was also industries minister, viewed that a congenial climate for industrialisation is still absent from the country, resulting in total stagnation in the industrial sector.
