# Plea to find out clue to rheumatic heart disease

licalth and Family Welfare Adviser Prof. M. A. Majed Tuesday urged medical scientists to find out the cause of rheumatic fever and heart disease and the ways to control and prevent them, reports

lnaugurating the pilot project centre for control and prevention of rheumatic fever and rheumatic heart disease at the Suhrawardhy Hospital premises in Dhaka. Dr. Majed said. "We must share the benefits of scientific and technological developments all over the world and relieve the people from the curse of these dis-

He said the government was thinking of ensuring health for all by providing primary health

care services. Presided over by Additional Health Secretary, Dr. K. M. Fariduddin, the function was also addressed by Health Secretary Khandakar Asaduzzaman, Japanese Ambassador in Bangladesh, Takeo Iguchi, Project Director, Dr. Strajul Haque and team leader of Japanese experts. Dr. K. Yoshitake

Referring to the Japanese assistance for socio-economic development of Bangladesh. Mr. Takeo lguchi said, 'we have particular programme for humanitarian assistance especially in health and agriculture sectors."

He said Japan had provided considerable assistance for the development of the Cardiovascular Disease Institute at the Suhrawardhy Hospital. The present project was a symbol of friendship between Japan and Bangladesh, he added.

The objective of the project is to establish national strategy for control and prevention of rheumatic fever and rheumatic heart disease (RF/RHD), to reduce incidence of the disease, to conduct research and provide health education in this

Dr. Sirajul Haque said seven persons in every one thousand people in the country suffer from rheumatic heart disease and one-third of the heart disease patients admitted in the hospitals were suffering from rheumatic heart disease

He said 80 per cent of the patients operated in the Heart Disease Institute and Hospital during the last 10 years were due to damage of valve caused by rheumatic fever. A valve operation cost about Taka three lakh whereas the disease could be prevented within five years at a cost of Taka 500 only, he added.

Assisted by Japan through the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), the pilot project is provided with modern and sophisticated facilities and is expected to con tribute a lot to control and prevent rheumatic sever and rheumatic heart disease.

Khandaker Asaduzzaman said during the 4th five year plan, the government planned to strengthen the preventive measures of diseases and the RF/RHD pilot project was a part of that measure for a particular disease.

Later, the Adviser distributed certificates to 20 trainee Doctors and 14 trainee Medical Assistants of the pro-
