Muslim League favours form of government through a "happy marriage between the presidential and parliamentary systems," reports UNB.

Announcing the party's election manifesto at a press conference in Dhaka on Thursday afternoon Muslim League President Kazi Abdul Kader said neither absolute presidential system nor rigid parliamentary system can be effective in the context of the country's socio-economic and political realities.

Kader further said his party if elected, will waive land tax up to 25 bighas, take steps to provide housing facilities for the homeless and solve unemplayment problem, lease water bodies to bonafide fishermen, promote industrialisation and

encourage foreign investment. Muslim League also favours increased budgetary allocation for education sector, ensure medicare for all, establish four medical universities and four women universities in four di-
