Among the street criers who have survived a metropolis racing to meet a future mixed with technological victories and ancient comforts, the 'chabiwallah' 'Key' man is probably the most familiar. People awash with nostalgia remember his voice among the many voices that crowd the so many pasts. Even senior citizens can recall the rhythmic black, now bleached by the angry sun and holding

jangle of the key repair man walking the streets and lesser lanes, hoping that forgetfulness and careless humans will provide him with a living. He is not so much a tradesman as he is a testimony to the fallibility of man. He reminds his customers how narrow is the distance between commanding the door and the helplessness of being locked out. The almirah always so willing and compliant can turn obstinate in a second till the key man comes to the res-

Yet this man with a loop in his hand around which hang many specimens and different shapes barely makes a living. sessed, the hungry among the unfed. There is a simple division among the locksmiths and the keymen. While the former can claim a place in the foothpath and a kind of permanent semipenury even if he tends to commercial clients, he does not have much "romance" around him. He is stuck to an area of wealth and greed, of sudden and desperate needs. Perhaps Kazi Abdur Rashid, enthroned on the roadside of Motijheel can say that he is at the top of the profession. His take home crosses Tk. 5000 of month on the average, and there must be moments when anxious millionaires and accountants have sought his services and rewarded him with unexpected sums
