# Khulna Varsity to start classes from July

KHULNA, Apr 5: The University Grants Commission, has decided to give the permission to start classes of the Khulna University from next July, as per previous schedule, reports BSS.

While visiting the Khulna University site here at Gallamari, at the head of threemember delegation UGC Chairman Prof. Shamsul Hug. disclosed this while talking to a cross section of people of the city on Thursday in connection with the progress of work of the university.

The UGC delegation also reviewed the architectural model of the university complex and the progress of ongoing projects as they went round the university campus. Prof Hug also exchanged

views with local elite on the academic subjects to be initially introduced. The final decision on the issue will be taken in the next meeting of the Grants Commission on April 9, the UGC chief said.

The Vice-Chancellor and Project Director of the Khulna University. Dr Prof Golam Rahman, informed that arrangements had already been completed for the start of the classes from next July on four subjects. He also informed that the local educational institutions reiterated their full cooperation in the holding of

classes in their respective institutions pending the availability of sufficient space and accommodation at the university campus.

The delegation was told that 80 per cent of the construction work of the university buildings had been completed and teachers had also been appointed to start classes on four subjects.

The University for general subjects at Khulna will be the country's seventh seat for higher learning.

Presently there are four general universities and a technological and an agricultural university.
