# Record paddy harvest likely

Farmers will reap a record IRRI-Boro harvest this season, if not affected by flash floods within a fortnight, experts predicted on Monday .

'It's an unforescen production with unusually long sheaves," one of the leading experts at the Agriculture Extention Department told

The government has set a target of producing 70 lakh tons of IRRI-Boro paddy this season, and the experts hope the target would be fulfilled.

Last year's production stood at 61.67 metric tons.

Reports from northern districts said there might be a bumper production of high yielding variety (HYV) and local variety of the dry-season paddy in terms of yield.

But acreage may fall below the target because many farmers could not bring their targeted areas under irrigation due to an unusual high price of fuel oil in the wake of recent Gulf crists.

The drive aims at ensuring fair price to the growers and building food reserve for the lean period

The agriculture department has suggested arrangements for mechanical driers for drying the usually wet Boro to minimise wastage in procure-

Reports from haor and beel areas, where Boro is harvested four to six weeks earlier, say the local variety of paddy now sells at Tk 160-180 a maund.


The government regrets that the wrong impression about the incident has been created abroad due to a baseless propaganda resorted to by the interested quarters.

## Diarrhoea claims six: 500 affected

KHULNA, Apr 22: About 500 diarrhoea patients were admitted to Khulna Infectious Disease Hospital and Khulna Shishu Hospital since April 14. Of them six persons including two minor boys died.

It is reported that hundreds of diarrhoea patients could not be admitted to Khulna Infectious Disease Hospital due to inhuman behaviour of doctors and staff of the hospital.

Some of them died reportedly while they were refused to get admission in the hospital. Both Infectious Disease and Shishu Hospitals have only 20 beds. Many patients are kept on the floors without any practical medicare. Oral saline are also reported to be inadequate

in both the hospitals.

The Civil Surgeon of Khulna Dr. Sk. Alimuzzaman told The Daily Star yesterday that 48 anti-diarrhoeal medical teams were working round the clock in the district to combat the disease.

He further said that control room has been set up at the sadar hospital while the disease broke out in the last month. It may be mentioned that

more than 20 persons died in the month of March in Khulna. Five persons were died in the Infectious Disease Hospital alone. The beds of the hospitals should be immediately expanded to cope with growing number of diarrhoea patients, many said.

#### DU teachers go on token strike today Teachers of the Dhaka

University will observe a two hour work abstention from 1 am today (Tuesday) to protest the recent incident in which miscreants threatened one of their colleagues, reports UNB.

The Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) which called the token strike will also bring out a silent procession on the campus at 11.30 am and hold a protest rally at he Central Shaheed Minar.

A group of students misbehaved with seven teachers of the Mass Communication and Journalism Department April 11. They also allegedly threatened to kill Dr. A. A. M. S. Arefin Siddiqi, an Assistant Professor of the Department and Joint Secretary of DUTA.

Today's token strike of the teachers is the first such programme in the Dhaka University campus after the fall of Ershad regime December 6 last year.
