Stock of oil sufficient

CHITTAGONG. May 8: There is sufficient stock of fuel oil and oil products in the country and as such there is no possibility of fuel crisis in future, reports BSS.

This information was given to Dr. Khandaker Musharral Hussain State Minister for Energy and Mineral Resources, while he visited different depots and jetties of oil sales companies in Chittagong on Wednesday.

The State Minister was also informed that an extensive emergency measure had been taken to keep the supply of fuel oil in the country normal and static.

The State Minister was told that fuel oil supply from Chittagong to different districts, upazilas and other parts of Dhaka, Khulna and Rajshahi divisions had been restored since May 6 under the emergency measure. Sending of necessary oil products like diesel, petrol and lubricating oil started on Monday by sea and roads to various parts of the country from all oil sales companies.

It was further informed that two jetties out four of Padma. Jamuna and Meghna Oil Sales Companies had already been made completely operative. The rest two others have also been made functional on temporary basis. The Eastern Refinery is being repaired and renovated on emergency basis with a view to make it operational by May 15.
