of Bhola with two naval boats and a few Japanese built rescue boats were trying to reach the offshore islands with relief materials. But the Deputy Commissioner of Bhola told this Correspondent over telephone Saturday that it could not be possible to conduct relief operation to remote islands due to shortage of deep draft river craft.

The Regional Relief Coordination Centre headquarters led by Major Gen R A M Golam Muktadir has been shifted to Bhola. The district administration has been working round the clock to redress the sufferings of half a million eyclone victims joining hands with army, navy and local political parties.

Meanwhile, diarrhoea has

already broken out at different places of Bhola. Non-government organisations working at the islands fear massive spread of infectious diseases at Bhola as aftermath of 29 April's devastating cyclone.
