### A Scene on the Street

In most cities in Asia, it is fascinating to watch variations in street scenes, reflecting affluence or poverty of a particular locality.

In many ways, it is not all that different in Dhaka. After all, driving through Gulshan and Banani - or even riding a bus in that area - one gets a fair idea of the life style, not to mention the income level, of people living there. To contrast it with what one might see in say, parts of Mohammadpur or Katabon would be

painful. If you are riding a bus and going about in a rickshaw, you hardly notice these variations. The suffocating traffic congestions, the pollution caused by both noise and black fumes and the discomfort (or perhaps the hazard) of riding an overcrowded bus, leave your senses in a state of numbness. The result, you keep overlooking a few little things which add some colour to our life in Dhaka. Yet many also ignore some signs of how tiny a section of people who, once written off by society are making valiant efforts to stand on their own feet.

To this small section belongs Amena, whom I came to know




