

Travel tax reduced to 10 p.c.

The Bangladeshis travelling abroad by air will now require to pay lesser travel tax than before, according to the proposed budget 1991-92, placed in the Jatiya Sangsad on Wednesday, reports BSS.

To make the tax rates "fair and reasonable", the Finance Minister Saifur Rahman said it is proposed to impose travel tax at the rate of 10 per cent of the fare, subject to a minimum of Taka 250 and maximum of Taka 1500. At present the rate is 12.5 per cent of the fare subject to a minimum of Taka 250 and maximum Taka 2000.

The Finance Minister said that the present rates of foreign travel tax seem "somewhat burdensome" to travelling public. But for travellers to SAARC countries the maximum rate would remain unchanged at Taka 500.

Similarly, for foreign travel by land route it was proposed to fix Taka 150 per traveller in place of the present Tk 250, and for travel by sea route at Tk 500 in place of the present Taka 800.


